Summer is almost over and we are looking forward to fall. Our calendar for the rest of the year is filling up with lots of great programs. Make sure to save the calendar from this newsletter! Also, log on to our website, follow the library on Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, or Twitter, read the Pulaski Citizen, listen to WKSR, watch PES Channel 3 or come in to the library and pick up fliers for all of the programs we have planned.

We have started a new Do-it-Yourself (DIY) series. The first one happened in August and the topic was growing your own herbs and ways to use them. The next event in this series is scheduled for Monday, September 24<sup>th</sup> at 5:30PM, and the topic is DIY decorative painting with Marion Ibsen. She will demonstrate how you can paint various crafts and decorations for your own home. It will be a fun event!

On October 18<sup>th</sup>, an author event with cookbook author Sheree Rose Kelley is the next event in the DIY series. Her cookbook is titled *Breads and Spreads*. Sheree will be demonstrating a few of her recipes and discussing her cookbook with us. This should be a wonderful author/DIY event.

Story Time has returned to its regular time slot of Fridays at 10:15AM with Miss Elizabeth. On September 14<sup>th</sup> we will have a special Puppet Show at the 10:15AM story hour and again at 4:00PM for ages 5 & up. This puppet show will be based on the story of Anansi the spider, highlighting African culture.

We are putting on our fabulous Halloween Putt-Putt event for

kids this year on October 27<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 – 6:00PM. This is Putt-Putt at its best with literary themed putting holes throughout the stacks of books in the library. Make sure to have your Halloween costume ready and start practicing putting for a spooky fun time in the library!

A joint author event with the Giles County Historical Society is planned for Sunday, November 4<sup>th</sup> at 2:00PM with author Bill Carey. His new book is titled *Runaways, Coffles and Fancy Girls: A History of Slavery in Tennessee*. Mr. Carey has written several books including *Fortunes, Fiddles and Fried Chicken: A Nashville Business History*. He also writes for the Tennessee Magazine.

Other special events include a Harry Potter & Fantastic Beasts Wizarding World Trivia Night, Family Keepsake Christmas Plates, library Christmas tea, themed story times, and all of our regular programs during each month. We will also start taking entries in December for our third annual Arts & Crafts Exhibition.

Amnesty for library fines starts September 17<sup>th</sup> and ends September 30<sup>th</sup>. For amnesty, you can bring in your overdue materials and be forgiven of any late charges on those materials as long as the materials are still in good condition.

In November, we are doing Food for Fines. During Food for Fines, you can bring in unexpired canned food or non-perishable food items, and be relieved of fines you owe on previously checked out items. One can or box of an unexpired food item equals \$5.00 worth of fines up to \$100 maximum. We will donate food collected to our local food banks to help with the holidays.

Over 170 Giles County students registered and participated in Summer Reading, which ran from June 4<sup>th</sup> to July 13<sup>th</sup>. We are so proud of our students who read 4,560 books in just six weeks!

The Summer Reading theme for this year was Libraries Rock, which promoted reading with the added fun of music! The library held 29 programs in all three branches of the Giles County Library. The programs consisted of 1,367 attendees, which included children, teenagers, parents, and individual patrons. We are also happy to have teamed up with the Boys & Girls Club and the Rec Center Kidz Camp to have regular weekly programs with their students.

None of this would have been possible without the wonderful help from our community members. We give special thanks to Tristar Reads, Savannah Jenkins from the Giles County Health Department, Taylor Gobble from the UT Extension Office, Rob Lindelof of PAC Fitness, and David Crane and David Robertson with the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency for putting on these amazing weekly programs for our readers each week!

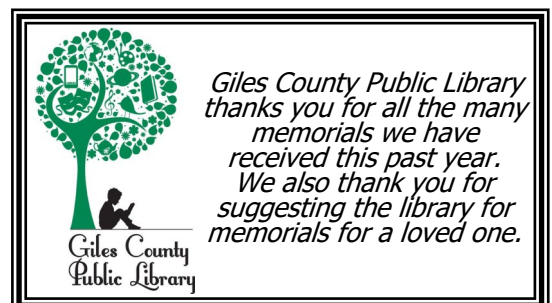
