# Lent 2018 Thy Will Be Done



Drawing from Christ's prayer in Gethsemane, "Thy will be done," this Lenten series reflects on how we can seek God's will in all aspects in our lives. We'll use the biblical characters of Abraham, Moses, David, Mary, Paul, and Lydia as reference points in our own lives. This material comes from Creative Communications for the Parish.

#### February 14 - Ash Wednesday

Genesis 15:12-15

"God's Will and God's Promise"

Abraham and his offspring will have to endure a period of oppression before receiving God's promises. Lent is traditionally a time of denial so we may come to experience God's grace more fully.

#### February 18 – First Sunday of Lent

9:00 Youth Sunday

10:15 One and All Exodus 2:11-15

"God's Will and Our Inadequacy"

This is the story of Moses murdering an Egyptian and then fleeing Egypt. Moses, who would lead the Hebrew people out of Egyptian slavery, was a flawed and sinful person. Yet God uses us, who are sinners, to do God's will.

#### February 25 - Second Sunday of Lent

Psalm 51:1-12

"God's Will and God's Forgiveness

This Psalm is attributed to David and is placed in the context of David's sin with Bathsheba. David pleads for God's forgiveness and "a new and right spirit" that will guide David to a better way of living.

The youth will be leading worship at the 9:00 AM service on February 18, and the theme is "A Place at the Table."


### Upcoming Youth Special Events -
