

### "NEED FOR NATIONAL ARCHERY HERO" by Mark Markwort

Who is the world's champion archer of 1961? What? You don't know? Okay, let's make it easier. Who is the 1961 national champion? What? You still can't answer. You are in the sporting goods business-don't you think you should know? Most of you can reel off top names at the drop of a hat when it comes to other sports.

Well, don't blame yourself. Very few casual archers themselves know. You'd be surprised how few of the serious archers know. I couldn't answer those questions myself if they were put to me in the above words.

Nine out of ten dealers to Hill. would hesitate a minute then doubtfully hazard. "Howard Hill?" The dealer would have given the same answer in the 1930s, the 1940s and in the 1950s. Now we are well into the 1960s and nothing has been done to change that picture. Howard Hill well deserves his fame, I am proud of my first-name acquaintance with him and I treasure the autographed copies of his books. For more than 30 years his has been the ONLY archery name where the public is concerned.

He has been the one figure most responsible for creating new archers, young and old. Every archery manufacturer in the country owes part of his success, whether

he will admit it or not.

However, the old master has been out of competitive archery for years. I, for one, don't blame him. He doesn't. have to jeopardize his fame by risking an off day at national compe-

Not that he has many off-days; this I want to make very clear.

Recently I was advised by an archer friend, "Don't ever go bow hunting with Howard. If you do you won't get a shot. He can still pop off the head of a roadrunner bird moving at full speed."

Hill, and he is a modest gentleman, will readily admit that he is not "national champion" in the usually accepted sense of the term.

The above quotation pretty well summarizes Howard Hill's place in archery. Champions come and go in the various phases of archery, but only one remains head and shoulders above the rest. This has been done through a lifetime devoted to archery and love for the sport.

Even through the great build-up of archery in the past 12 years, for which he was primarily responsible. through the influence of his pictures, books, exhibitions, etc., his is the only name to remain prominent to the extent that he is welcomed by the press and TV. His articles are sought after by magazines and his actions are newsworthy.

Hunting with the bow appealed to Howard much more than did target archery. Consequently his love of hunting was to take him to all parts of the world following the game trails and pitting his skill against all kinds of game, some that nearly cost him his life

Howard's greatness is probably reflected most in his long list of game taken with bow and arrow, dating back to 1925 when he bagged his first moose and white tail deer while on a hunting trip in Canada. From 1925 until the present time, Howard compiled a record of kills that will undoubtedly never be equalled.

### WHY I SHOOT THE LONG BOW

It must be remembered that the modern glass laminated bows used today are faster than the bow of past years. I have always said and still maintain that no person should shoot a bow he cannot draw with ease. Being first of all a hunter, I wanted a bow that would throw a heavy hunting arrow with as little are as possible. To achieve this end I knew I would have to increase the pounds pull of my bow, and I worked toward this result. I started with a bow that I could pull easily. By practicing constantly and gradually increasing the pull of my bows. I developed over a period of years the muscles to pull very heavy bows with no undue strain.

For many years I could handle perfectly bows pulling up to 100 pounds at 28 inches, though

my favorite weight for hunting was between 80 and 90 pounds. Few men have ever spent enough time to develop sufficient strength for handling easily such heavy bows as these. Even today at the age of 62 years, I can draw and shoot with ease and comfort a 75 lb. hunting bow. In fact, two or three times each week I go out in my back yard and shoot a bow of that weight for from 30 mimites to an hour and a half, shooting from 110 to 150 arrows.



Even the mighty elephant succumbed to a specially made, larger version of this broadhead. Two of its most important attributes are that it will not windplane under any conditions and it is designed for penetration. This broadhead will not fold up or fly apart on contact with large bones (See illustration below).




### HOW TO ORDER ARCHERY EQUIPMENT

The bows, arrows, and accessories described in this catalog are available at most sporting goods stores wherever quality archery equipment is sold. Your local dealer will help you select the proper equipment for you. If you cannot locate a Howard Hill dealer in your locality, please order direct.

### WHEN ORDERING BOWS

Be sure and specify catalog number, length of bow, right or left hand and weight desired at your draw length. Most bows are weighed in at 28" draw length and you can add or subtract approx. 2 lbs. per inch for longer or shorter draws.

Do not over-bow yourself. Archery is a test of skill not of strength. You can build yourself up to handle most any bow, but you can learn better archery faster with a light bow. A man's target bow usually varies from 35 to 45 lbs. and the ladies from 20 to 30 lbs. A child's bow (depending on age and muscular development) will vary from 15 to 35 lbs. For hunting we recommend from 45 to 75 lbs. depending on the weight you can handle easily.




### WHEN ORDERING ARROWS

An arrow must be the correct stiffness or spine to fly correctly from your pound bow at your draw length. To determine your draw

length place a yardstick in the center of your chest and extend hands forward, with palms inward, as shown. The arrow length is determined by where the fingertips touch the yardstick.

The factory measures the arrow from the bottom of the groove in nock to the back of the point. Usually %" extra is allowed for clearance of the fingers on broadhead arrows (or field points to be interchangeable with broadheads). Be sure and specify arrow draw length, pound bow at your draw, estalog number and type of points desired.
