Learning about fire safety

Each year a Franklin Fire Fighter presents fire safety to the children. On Monday, November 5th, our Franklin Fire Fighter will arrive around 9:30am. He/She will show the children how fire fighters dress for a fire, put on their gear, talk about what to do if a fire happens in the home and discuss how to prevent fires. The goal is to teach awareness of what to do and what to expect in case there is a fire at home. Some young children may initially be anxious when the fire fighter puts on the gear, however, the children will get to see the gear prior to the presentation. If we are lucky, our fire fighter will arrive in a Franklin Fire Truck, and the children will get to see it up close, weather permitting.
