Charlotte, NC – The Charlotte Catholic High School Foundation is proud to announce the 2017 winner of its annual Service Award, Kayleigh Anne Ruller. The award was presented during the CCHS Senior Awards Ceremony held on May 31st at St. Matthew Catholic Church.

The CCHS Foundation Service Award was established to recognize a graduating senior solely for his or her community service. It is presented to a senior who not only spends many hours serving the community, but also who chooses several different kinds of service, perhaps taking the student out of his or her comfort zone. School spirit, empathy, compassion, dedication, and diversity of service are all characteristics of the winner of this scholarship. CCHS Campus Ministry faculty and staff nominate students who meet the criteria. A Selection Committee, comprised of the Campus Ministry Director, a Guidance Counselor, a member of the CCHS Foundation Board of Directors, and a member of the CCHS Administration, select the winner.

The diversity and amount of Kayleigh's service to the community impressed the Selection Committee. She has volunteered with a muffin ministry for the homeless at her church, as a Peer Minister at CCHS, with Faith Formation at her church, as a Student Ambassador at CCHS, on the Retreat Team at school, and at the Blumenthal Theatre in the community.

Jamie Boll, secretary of the CCHS Foundation, presented the award. "Being a part of this Catholic community, you know your real legacy as a class is your service to others," he said. "Kayleigh has embraced that part of our faith, and we are very proud of her for it."

Kayleigh will attend the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in the fall.
