The workshop is hosted by Father Cecil Critch, Provincial Spiritual Advisor

The focus of the workshop will be on the new theme “ **Inspired by the Spirit, Women**

Respond to God's Call”. Together we will reflect on the theme in three different sessions, namely:

1. How we respond to the Theme Individually and in Community(parish and provincial councils, broader community)
2. How the theme relates to Pope Francis' new Corporal Works of Mercy: Care for Our Common Home and his message in Laudato Si'.
3. How the theme directs our response to “ Medically Assisted Dying”.

We will begin the morning with Mass in St Edward's Church (adjoining the Parish Hall) at 9:30am. It will be the Mass for the Feast of the Annunciation.

After the session on medically assisted dying, presented by Dr Rick Singleton we will again go to the church and pray together Sr. Nuala Kenny's “Way of the Cross: Reflections on Suffering of Sick and Dying”.
