There are some areas of the course that are intended to be playable, but are not due to water damage. To clarify this, the board agreed to the following addition to our local rules:

Abnormal Ground Conditions - The dips in the general areas of Butterfield Stage #1, #5, and #10 that are a mess from flooding and/or roped off are *abnormal ground conditions*, and you may take free relief under Rule 16.1b. The creek crossing in front of the tee on Butterfield Stage #4 is a *penalty area*.


