2024 MIWW entry fees:

\$12 non-refundable entry fee payable to National MIWW for each entry in all age Divisions. SD entry fee (payable to SD MIWW) is \$3/fabric sample to cover wool testing.

State Level Contest Division Only

Recycled Wool ~ any item or garment made from a wool garment/blanket etc. **Quilt, Afghan or Novelty** ~ quilts, wall-hangings, knitted or crocheted items, or novelty items made primarily of wool.

No National entry fees for these divisions. State entry fee of \$5 per entry.

Wool Testing & Entry Forms/Fees

Wool fabrics & fibers used in Junior, Senior and Adult/Professional divisions MUST be at least 60% wool. All divisions are encouraged to meet this same criteria.

Entry forms, fees & fabric samples are due at least 1 week prior to district contests. Fabric samples (5-inch square of each fabric & 36 inches of each yarn used) may be sent in for testing earlier. Send fabric samples and all info to:
