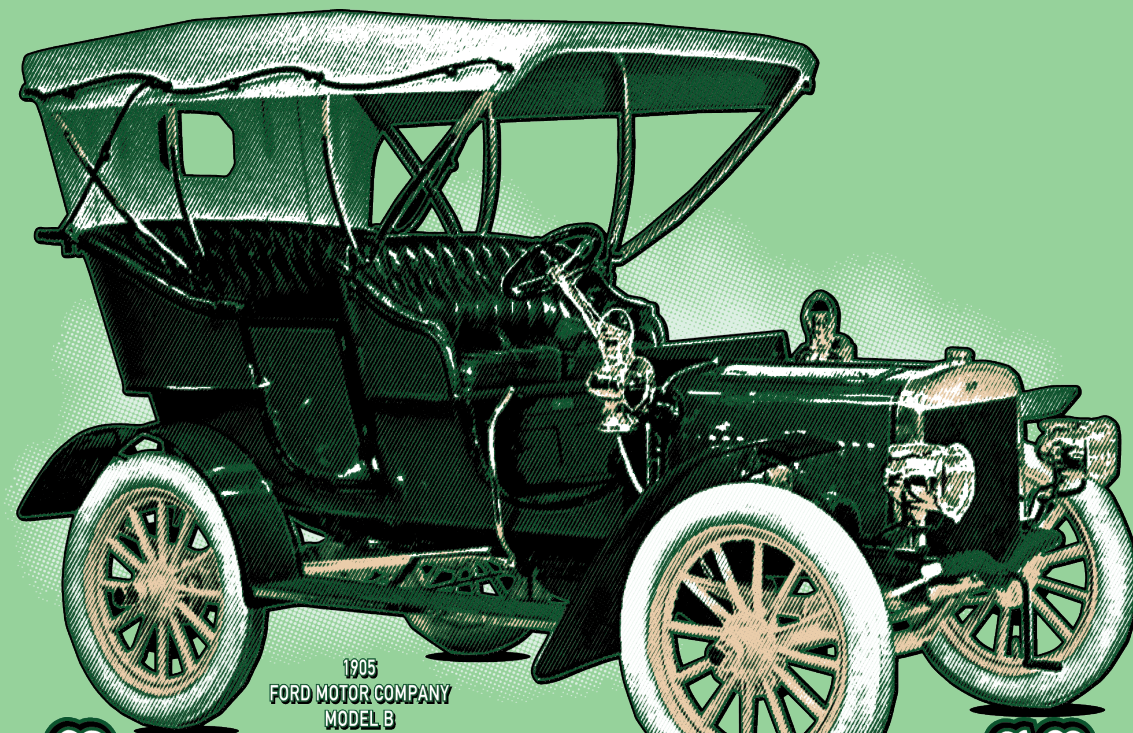
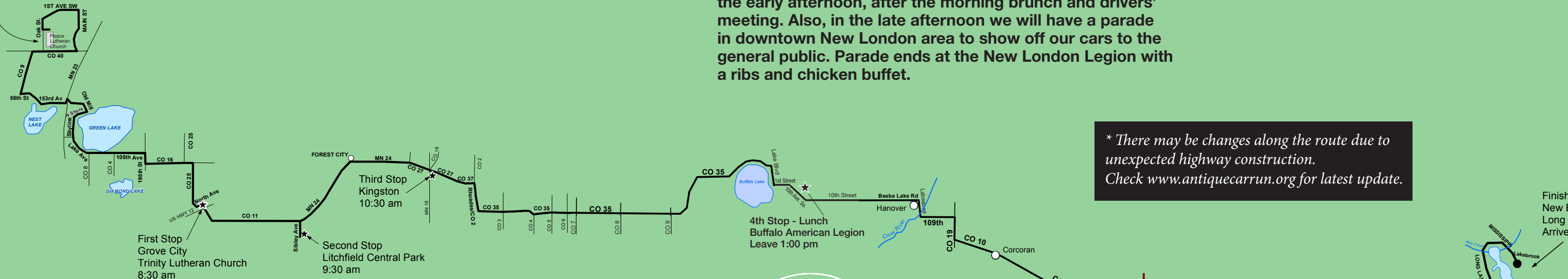

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS...

Wednesday, August 9

- Brut Worm Farms & Max Bats (50-mile tour)
 This morning the tour will start from our registration spot at Peace Lutheran church in New London. We will tour Brut Worm Farm; it is a family-owned company in the heart of Minnesota farm country. The farm produces worm castings and worm tea, a natural soil fertilizer. Come see this interesting farm. Next, we will tour Max Bats which manufactures custom wood bats for the baseball professional to the high school and youth baseball players. You are invited to see this well-known manufacturing facility. Lunch to follow at the Brooten Pavilion. The evening get together will be at Neer Park in New London.

Thursday, August 10

- Kandiyohi County Fair (45 mile tour)
 This morning the tour will also start from Peace Lutheran Church. We will be traveling to Willmar, the home to the annual Kandiyohi County Fair. The fair offers something for everyone – from baking and flowers to livestock and antique tractors. Come enjoy the contests, food, singing, food, grandstand entertainment and, of course, the food!  - ✦ Crystal – 2:00 pm, Crystal Community Center, corn feed and car show hosted by Crystal Lions Club
- New Brighton Finish Line, 3:00 - 6:00 pm, Long Lake Regional Park, hosted by Stockyard Days – food, entertainment, fireworks

- 37th Annual New Brighton Car Show & Swap Meet in Long Lake Regional Park where Stockyard Days continues.
