Calum Sutherland delivered a career-long 53-yard field goal with 1:44 to play in the game to give ULM a 31-28 upset victory over Liberty. The War Hawks were 32.5-point underdogs and as high as 41/1 on the money-line! It was the biggest upset involving two FBS teams since 2012!

 The Fresno St/Wyoming game went UNDER the total by 36.5 points.  
 The Louisiana Tech/UTEP game went UNDER the total by 32.5 points.  
 The Florida/LSU game went OVER the total by 30 points.  
 UTSA is 6-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 8.3 ppg!  
 Michigan is 5-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 11.9 ppg!  
 Missouri has failed to cover the spread in 10 straight games by an average of 11.4 ppg.  
 New Mexico is 0-7 ATS this year failing to cover by 10.9 ppg!  
 Clemson is 0-6 ATS this year failing to cover the spread by 12.2 ppg!  
 The OVER is 5-1 in WKU games going OVER by an average of 13.4 ppg!  
 The UNDER is 6-0 in Purdue games going UNDER by an average of 16.7 ppg!

## Misleading Finals

**Texas Tech beat Kansas 41-14.** However, Kansas got 2 TD drives in the final minute after trailing 41-0 in the 4Q.

**Tulsa beat South Florida 32-31.** Tulsa had a 535-268 yard edge including 269-113 on the ground but were -2 in TO's. USF led 24-20 at the half on a 100-yard kickoff return and a 69-yard interception return on the ensuing Tulsa possession.

**Fresno St beat Wyoming 17-0.** However, Wyoming had a 271-259 yard edge but were -5 in TO's. The Bulldogs scored all their points off turnovers, the three scoring drives covering a total of only 50 yards.

## Bad Beats

**The Navy/Memphis game had a total of 55.5** Memphis led 35-17 with 6:07 left in the 3Q but neither team scored again.

**Minnesota was leading Nebraska 21-16** with 5 minutes left in the fourth quarter. UNDER 48.5 bettors had to feel okay about their chances. However, Minnesota got a safety to lead 23-16. After the kickoff, Minnesota only needed a couple of first downs to ice the game. Instead they get a 56-yard TD run with 2:12 left to go up 30-16. Then Nebraska went 75 yards in 6 plays getting a TD with 1:12 left to put the game OVER the total.

**Akron (+20)** got a 50-yard TD pass with :31 left to get the back-door vs Miami, Oh.

**Kentucky (+21.5)** went 75 yards in 22 plays (11:23 time of possession) getting a TD with :04 left for the back-door vs Georgia (lost 30-13). During the drive, Kentucky converted a pair of 4th-Downs. They also called time out right before their TD instead of letting the clock run out. For the first time all season, the Bulldogs gave up two touchdowns in a game. "There may only be 4 seconds left in the fourth quarter, but we still don't want anybody in our end zone," Georgia linebacker Adam Anderson said. "I'm still hurting right now." Georgia backers are also hurting.

The UNDER in Vanderbilt/South Carolina won while we suffered close losses on Northern Illinois and the OVER in the WKU/ODU game. ### Games in Rotation Order Wednesday, October 20th

**Coastal Carolina 31 APPALACHIAN ST 28.** Appalachian St has only been a home underdog 3 times (1-2 ATS) since joining the FBS in 2014. It is deserved here as Coastal is No. 1 in the country in yards per play margin (+4.37), No. 1 in yards per game margin (+284) and No. 1 in points per game margin (+33.8). The problem is Coastal hasn't played a single team in the Top 100 of our power ratings and this is a big step up in class for them. App St was embarrassed in their last game, a blowout loss at ULL. We bet numbers, not teams. We took Coastal +1 on the openers but would lean with App St at the current numbers.

### Thursday, October 21st

**SMU 41 Tulane 27.** Both teams come in off a bye. SMU is a perfect 6-0 and incredibly has allowed just 1 sack on 228 pass attempts this year! Meanwhile, Tulane's season has taken a turn for the worse as they've lost and failed to cover the spread in 4 straight games. We don't think it gets any better here. We have a slight lean on the UNDER.

**UL-Lafayette 40 ARKANSAS ST 24.** Last week, ULL played by far their best game of the season as they blew out Appalachian St as home dogs. They're taking on an Arkansas St team that statistically is one of the worst in the country. The Red Wolves are -143.8 ypg (No. 124), -16.7 ppg (No. 123) and are dead-last in a favorite "Wise Guy" metric yards per play (-2.59). That's one of the reasons why you've seen money come in on ULL this week. The UNDER is 5-1 in ULL games and that is where our lean is.

**Florida Atlantic 32 CHARLOTTE 24.** Our favorite bet we made on the openers this week was FAU -2. We liked it so much, once most books opened Sunday night, we gave them out at -5 to our VIP customers as one of our top plays of the week. We still lean that way even at -7. FAU is much better in ypp (No. 64 vs No. 109) and has played the tougher schedule than Charlotte.

**San Jose St 27 UNLV 21.** UNLV is 0-6 on the season but four of those losses have come by 8 points or less against a pretty rugged schedule. Their stats aren't impressive including a MINUS-17 sack differential and they can't keep their QB's healthy. Local news here in Vegas on Tuesday night seems to think QB Cameron Friel will play here after getting banged up vs Utah St last week. Meanwhile, San Jose St broke their 5-game ATS losing streak last week in a near upset of San Diego St. We don't see much value here.

### Friday, October 22nd

**Middle Tennessee 34 CONNECTICUT 20.** UConn comes in off their first win in two years last week as they upset FCS Yale 21-15 as 3.5-point home underdogs. This maybe a tough spot for them playing a 9th straight week on one day less rest. Meanwhile, Middle Tennessee comes in fresh off a bye. The Blue Raiders have an easy slate down the stretch and can start a run towards a bowl with a win here. We don't see much value here.

**CENTRAL FLORIDA 33 Memphis 30.** UCF is really struggling without QB Dillon Gabriel. The Knights have failed to cover in 4 straight games (3 without Gabriel) and now you have to wonder if bowl eligibility will be a struggle to get to. Meanwhile, Memphis got a nice win and cover over Navy last week to get their season back on track. The Tigers are No. 15 in ypp margin. We did bet UCF "Pick" on the openers but it wasn't one of our favorite bets we made.

**Colorado St 30 UTAH ST 26.** We really like what we're seeing out of Colorado St. The Rams have covered 4 straight games by an average of 18.6 ppg! We think y'all threw them in the trash after they lost to South Dakota St and Vanderbilt in their first two games. The Rams have one of the best defensive lines in college football as they have 21 sacks and are allowing just 98 rush ypg. We saw Utah St in person last week and we question if their offensive line can hold up here. We bet Colorado St -1 on the openers and gave them out as one of the top VIP plays of the week at -2.5. Clearly, there has been some value lost but we still lean Rams.

**Washington 30 ARIZONA 14.** Just when you thought it couldn't get any worse for Arizona, the Wildcats are now down to a 3rd string QB in Will Plumber. Arizona was shut-out by lowly Colorado 34-0 last week and have now lost 18 straight games! On the other side, Washington has been one of the biggest disappointments in CFB this year. The Huskies are 2-4 SU and 1-5 ATS. We're not sure we want to lay this kind of number with their offense that is averaging just 23.5 ppg. We lean Arizona even with the 3rd string QB.

### Saturday, October 23rd

**Western Michigan 28 TOLEDO 26.** Toledo OVER 7.5 wins was one of our favorite bets in the summer. However, the Rockets have now lost 3 games outright as a favorite and that OVER bet is all but toast. They're taking on a Western Michigan team who rebounded off the Ball St loss with a blowout of Kent St last week. Toledo has fared better in yards per play (No. 21 vs No. 85). We were hoping to get a "+4" number on Western here but that wasn't the case. Totals' players note the UNDER has cashed in 5 straight Toledo games. Pass.

**FLORIDA ST 47 Massachusetts 13.** Both teams come in off byes after notching their best performances of the season. The Noles have won back-to-back

games and are finally starting to turn a corner. They're taking on a UMass team that even with a win over UConn, are arguably the worst team in the country. The Minutemen are No. 129 in ypg differential (-188), No. 129 in ppg differential (-24.8) and No. 128 in ypp margin (-2.32). The Noles roll here but we're not fond of laying 5 TD's. Pass.

**GEORGIA ST 35 Texas St 25.** Statistically the two teams are close as Georgia St is No. 104 in yards per play margin while Texas St is No. 110. However, Georgia St has played the much tougher schedule and the Panthers come in off a bye. This one is close to our numbers on both the side and the total. Pass.

**Ohio St 40 INDIANA 20.** Prior to the bye, the Buckeyes were starting to resemble the team we expected them to be in 2021. They crushed Rutgers and Maryland and are now No. 2 in the country in yards per play margin (+3.39). QB CJ Stroud's Heisman chances have improved dramatically after throwing 10 TD passes with no interceptions in those two games. They're taking on an Indiana team that is 2-4 on the year and 0-5 ATS vs FBS team failing to cover by 11 ppg. They have lost 4 games to Iowa, Cincinnati, Penn St and Michigan St who are a combined 24-2 on the season. Keep in mind, Ohio St will have nearly half the crowd in this one but we don't see too much value.

**Buffalo 35 AKRON 23.** If you think this line is a bit short, it's because Buffalo is a little banged up. Plus the Bulls haven't exactly lit the world on fire this year at -0.72 in ypp margin (No. 107). Meanwhile, Akron has a couple wins this year but the Zips are No. 125 in ypp margin. Akron got a lucky back-door cover at Miami last week (see page 1) and the Zips have allowed 35 sacks already! We're not involved in this one.

**PENN ST 34 Illinois 10.** We bet Penn St on the openers here at -18. We thought that line was short regardless of whether starting QB Sean Clifford was going to play here or not. As we're typing this Tuesday night, we think Clifford is more doubtful than questionable. The Nittany Lions did have a bye week to get one of the younger guys ready. They won't have to do much considering how inept Illinois has been offensively this season. The Fighting Illini are No. 117 in ypp offense, No. 120 in scoring offense and No. 118 in yards per play on offense. They won't have much success here against a Penn St defense that is No. 4 in scoring and No. 5 in yards per play allowed. The UNDER is 6-1 in Illinois' games this year and at the current lines, that's where our lean is.

**VIRGINIA 33 Georgia Tech 27.** Virginia is off a 38-point cover vs Duke last week on top of winning two games on the final play vs Miami and Louisville because the opposing kicker missed game-winning FG's. We thought there would be value fading the Cavaliers here. Georgia Tech. The two teams are No. 47 and No. 48 in yards per play margin so they are very close stats' wise. However, we would have preferred the Jackets to be getting more than a TD. Totals' players note that while you think offense with Virginia, the UNDER is 6-1 in Virginia games this year. We lean UNDER.

### 2★ Boston College (plus the points) LOUISVILLE 30 Boston College 27.

Even though they have played a much weaker schedule, Boston College has been the better team statistically. BC has better ypp margin (No. 50 vs No. 81), scoring margin (No. 34 vs No. 71) and ypp margin (No. 66 vs No. 76). Last week's blowout loss to NC State was a bit misleading as BC muffed a punt and NC State returned it for a TD, then they threw an interception giving NC State a short field. "The 14 points, like that," BC coach Jeff Hefley said, snapping his fingers, "we just couldn't recover from. We were down at that point 24-7, and just felt like a little bit too much at that time." We expect this one to go down to the wire.

**VIRGINIA TECH 26 Syracuse 21.** At first, we were surprised to see how short this spread was. You have a 3-4 Syracuse team playing at a 3-3 Virginia Tech team. Then you start diving into the numbers which paint a much different story. Syracuse is out-gaining their opponents by 95 ypg (No. 31). Meanwhile, Virginia Tech is -43.5 ypg (No. 104). Syracuse is also a very solid No. 25 in yards per play margin (+1.28) while Virginia Tech is -0.49 (No. 101). Syracuse is 6-1 ATS this season but has lost each of their last 3 games in gut-wrenching fashion on the final play. Both head coaches are on the hot seat. We think this one goes down to the wire and we're not sure who to trust in late game-management. We like Syracuse coach Dino Babers but his game management has left a lot to be desired the last couple of weeks.

**PITTSBURGH 26 Clemson 25.** For those of you wondering when the last time Clemson was an underdog in an ACC game, it was in 2016 in the famous Lamar Jackson vs Deshaun Watson game where Clemson was a 1-point home underdog. The last time the Tigers were catching at least a FG was in 2014 at then defending national champ Florida St. It's been awhile. It is also deserved here. Statistically, Pitt has been dominant. The Panthers are No. 3 in ypp margin (+211), No. 4 in scoring margin (+28.3) and No. 12 in yards per play margin (+1.86). Meanwhile, Clemson has been one of the most disappointing teams in the country as the Tigers are 0-6 ATS failing to cover by 11.9 ppg. Their offense ranks No. 115 in ypg and No. 113 in scoring. All 5 of their games vs FBS teams have come down to the wire and we expect that to be the case here. We do find it interesting that in the summer the Westgate SuperBook here in Las Vegas opened Clemson as a 17.5-point favorite in this match-up.

**MINNESOTA 29 Maryland 23.** Minnesota has revenge for losing outright as a 18-point favorite last year. Statistically, the Terps are the superior team and are coming off a bye. The problem is they have lost two of their top 3 receivers for the season and they have multiple defensive starters out. Minnesota is 4-2 on the season despite being favored in only two games. The Gophers run the 2nd slowest tempo in college football so that is why we bet UNDER 57.5 on the Sunday openers.

**2★ UNDER 51 MICHIGAN 33 Northwestern 10.** We like the UNDER here. You have a Northwestern offense that is No. 110 in scoring and we don't think they have much success vs Michigan's No. 9 scoring defense. On top of that, you have a Michigan team that is No. 101 in the country in terms of plays per minute. We also like what we saw from the Northwestern defense off the bye week limiting the Scarlet Knights to just 7 points last week. Yes, Michigan is off a bye but we have to think they spent some time prepping for next week's showdown in East Lansing and won't "empty the clip" here. 8 of the last 10 meetings between these two have gone UNDER this 51 total.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN 31 Northern Illinois 26.** CMU is slightly better statistically as they are No. 92 in yards per play margin while Northern Illinois is No. 108. Central Michigan got a nice OT win over Toledo last week. Meanwhile, we were disappointed in the Huskies last week. They only beat Bowling Green by 8 as we dropped a best bet on these pages. Still, it was win No. 4 in a row for them after going winless in 2020. We don't see too much value here. **Kent St 33 OHIO 30.** We like Ohio here. The Bobcats are actually better in yards per play margin on the season (No. 84 vs No. 93). After a brutal 0-4 ATS start to the season, they've covered 3 straight MAC games. It makes sense as their staff is better equipped vs familiar conference foes after losing head coach Frank Solich in the summer. On top of that, they are getting better QB play. Last week, Armani Rogers had 183 yards rushing, including a 99-yard touchdown. It was the longest by a quarterback in NCAA history — beating what Arizona State's Mark Malone had against Utah State in 1979! We also lean UNDER as the two teams are a combined 10-4 to the UNDER this year.

**Cincinnati 40 NAVY 13.** The Bearcats are 5-0 ATS vs FBS teams this year with an average cover of 12.6 ppg. This team looks like they are on a mission and they deserve their lofty ranking as they are No. 3 in the country in yards per play margin (+3.65). Meanwhile, Navy ranks No. 122 in that yards per play category at -2.05. We lean OVER here as Navy's offense has been improved since firing their OC after week 2.

**NC State 29 MIAMI, FL 26.** We bet NC State +1 on the Sunday openers. Obviously, we thought it was a wrong team favored situation as NC State is No. 23 in yards per play margin (+1.29) while Miami is No. 52. A lot of Miami's offensive stats are useless now that they are down 4 offensive starters including QB D'Eriq King and their top 2 RB's. At 2-4 for the first time since 1997, you have to question their motivation especially after a tough loss. Meanwhile, NC State is playing for an ACC title. They already own the tie-breaker over Clemson and need to be locked in each week. At the current numbers, we lean OVER.

**3★ WAKE FOREST 29 Army 22.** We like Wake Forest in this game. The Demon Deacons have had an extra week to prepare for Army's option coming off the bye and only have Duke on deck. We think they'll be focused here and that goes a long way vs a Service Academy. We also think head coach Dave Clawson is one of the most underrated in the country and the betting markets under-rate Wake almost every year. Meanwhile, Army is -0.1 in yards per play margin this year and off a tough physical game vs Wisconsin where they left a lot on the table.

**Temple 28 SOUTH FLORIDA 27.** USF hasn't won a game vs an FBS opponent since 2019. They almost got one last week as they fell by one vs Tulsa. It was misleading though as Tulsa had a 535-268 yard edge. USF led 24-20 at the half on a 100-yard kickoff return and a 69-yard interception return. They're taking on a Temple team fresh off a bye. The Owls do have the superior stats here at No. 78 in ypp margin while USF is No. 123. Should the Bulls be favored here? Our power ratings think so, but we'll call for the small upset.

**Eastern Michigan 28 BOWLING GREEN 22.** Bowling Green beat us on these pages last week as the Falcons only lost by 8 at Northern Illinois. They did trail 34-16 in the fourth quarter. Despite a 2-5 SU record, the Falcons are 6-1 ATS on the year and we've upgraded them in our power ratings more than any team in the country. With that being said, our rating prefer Eastern Michigan here as the Eagles are on a 27-9 ATS run away from home since late in the 2015 season.

**HOUSTON 35 East Carolina 23.** Houston comes in off a bye. We usually are tough on Dana Holgorsen on these pages but the Cougars have rebounded nicely since the opener to win 5 straight. Their defense is allowing just 16 ppg. Meanwhile, ECU also comes in off a bye. At 3-3 and with games against USF, Temple and Navy still left, the Pirates have to be thinking bowl game. We don't see too much value in this one.

**Oklahoma 51 KANSAS 13.** Despite having a new coach Kansas is still Kansas as the Jayhawks are 0-5-1 ATS failing to cover by 9.75 ppg. They scored two TD's in the final minute vs Texas Tech last week to make that final more respectable (still lost 41-14). Kansas is dead last in scoring margin (-26.6 ppg). They're taking on an Oklahoma team that looks rejuvenated offensively with Caleb Williams at QB. It started in the Texas game and continued last week with their blowout win over TCU. OU can name the score here. Lean UNDER.

**BALL ST 28 Miami, Oh 24.** The Cardinals have obviously turned their season around with three straight wins and covers. They're now in good position to defend their MAC Championship. Meanwhile, Miami who won the MAC in 2019 and were only able to play 3 games a year ago also have their sights set on a division title. Surprisingly, the Red Hawks are the much more impressive team statistically. They are No. 56 in ypp margin while Ball St checks in at No. 100. Slight lean on Miami.

**WYOMING 30 New Mexico 9.** New Mexico's season has been a disaster. The Lobos are 0-7 ATS and have failed to cover their games by 10.9 ppg. They were down to a backup QB last week and managed just 76 yards vs Colorado St.

Fresh QB CJ Montes was 3-of-19 passing for 11 yards with two interceptions and starting QB Wilson is questionable again here. Meanwhile, Wyoming is off a misleading 17-0 loss to Fresno St where they were -5 in TO's. We could only look towards Wyoming here but we're not fond of laying 3 TD's with an offense averaging just 25 ppg.

**2★ Colorado (plus the points) CALIFORNIA 24 Colorado 19.** Both teams leave a lot to be desired especially on the offensive side of the ball. However, both are off two of their better performances of the season. Cal nearly upset Oregon while Colorado shutout Arizona 34-0. Cal is on a 0-10-1 ATS run as a home favorite failing to cover by 12.8 ppg! We certainly don't want to lay more than a TD with them here especially with an offense averaging just 23 ppg. Meanwhile, Colorado's defense only allows 19.8 ppg.

**Utah 30 OREGON ST 26.** Don't look now but the Utes are the only remaining unbeaten team in Pac-12 play. Back-to-back wins over USC and Arizona St have them in the driver's seat for the South division title. Utah is No. 26 in ypp margin but they're taking on a pesky Oregon St team fresh off a bye and the Beavers are No. 36 in ypp margin. Our numbers like Utah here but the spot isn't great for them.

**BYU 28 WASHINGTON ST 25.** Obviously, the big story here is Washington St football coach Nick Rolovich and four assistant coaches being fired Monday for refusing to comply with a mandate that required all state employees to be vaccinated against COVID-19. Ricky Logo (DT's), John Richardson (CB's, recruiting), Craig Stutzmann (co-OC, QB's) and Mark Weber (OL) were also fired. DC Jake Dickert is the interim coach. This was a Washington St team that had been on fire with 3 straight Pac-12 wins and 4 straight covers. On the other side, BYU looks like their wearing down once again after playing a rugged schedule. This has been the case every year under head coach Sitake with the exception being last year when they played a bunch of Group of 5 teams. The market moved 2.5-points off the Rolovich news. We lean UNDER.

**Oregon 30 UCLA 28.** One of the bigger home games UCLA has had in recent memory especially with *ESPN College GameDay* on hand. Both teams already with one conference loss and can ill afford another. The two teams are pretty even statistically but UCLA has played the tougher schedule. If you're wondering why UCLA is favored here, the Ducks are 0-5 ATS besides the win at Ohio St. They haven't looked the part in any of their other games. With that being said, Oregon is more talented than UCLA and we think they step up in class yet again in a big game.

**Kansas St 30 TEXAS TECH 29.** Texas Tech can clinch bowl eligibility with a win here. They're probably going to need it considering they close with Oklahoma, Iowa St, Oklahoma St and Baylor. Kansas St also needs it at 3-3. The Red Raiders are the better team statistically as they are No. 22 in ypp margin while Kansas St is No. 62. Our numbers like Texas Tech but Kansas St is the better coached and more reliable team in this spot.

**TCU 31 West Virginia 25.** We will see if the bye week helped reset West Virginia's season which has been a disappointment at 2-4 especially their last two games vs Texas Tech and Baylor. Meanwhile, TCU has also left a lot to be desired at 1-4-1 ATS. They need this win coming off the loss at Oklahoma last week. We bet TCU -3 on the openers because our numbers were strong on the Horned Frogs (see page 7). It wasn't our favorite bet of the week though.

**IOWA ST 28 Oklahoma St 20.** We circled Iowa St as a possible bet this week but the market is all over it. We have an unranked team favored by a TD over a Top 10 team. Don't be fooled by Iowa St's 4-2 record. The Cyclones are still No. 5 in the country in ypp margin (+2.37). We still have them in the Top 10 of our power ratings as they had dominant stat edges over Iowa and Baylor in those losses. Yes, the Cowboys are undefeated but they are only No. 65 in ypp margin and are off a big win at Texas where a long "Pick 6" completely changed that game.

**UAB 34 Rice 10.** We bet UAB -20 on the openers. It was more of a fade against a Rice team that is 1-5 ATS this season with the worst ATS margin in CFB at -18.3. UAB is off a 34-0 win over Southern Miss and they have a bye on deck so they should be focused here. The UNDER is 6-1 in UAB games and these two teams are in the bottom 5 in terms of plays per minute.

**ALABAMA 47 Tennessee 20.** Alabama was a nice winner for us on these pages last week as one of our top plays. The Crimson Tide got back on track with their most complete performance of the season in a 49-9 win. They're taking on a Tennessee team that has become a darling in the betting markets among the "Math guys." The Vols are No. 20 in ypp margin. The problem is they're not a well-oiled machine with untimely penalties, turnovers and QB injuries. Since Nick Saban took over in 2007, Alabama is 14-0 SU (+25.7 ppg) and 10-4 ATS (+6.1 ppg) in this series. We expect more of the same here.

**TEXAS A&M 34 South Carolina 13.** South Carolina barely survived a scare from Vanderbilt last week as we cashed the UNDER on these pages. Zeb Noland will get the start for the Gamecocks with QB Luke Doty now out for the year. We didn't make an adjustment in our ratings as South Carolina actually looked better earlier this season with Noland and he led the game-winning drive last week. Meanwhile, Texas A&M is playing their best ball of the season. The avoided the letdown after the big upset over Alabama by taking care of Missouri 35-14. We expect a similar outcome here.

**Mississippi St 37 VANDERBILT 15.** Vanderbilt came so close to getting their first SEC win in two years last week in a 21-20 loss. QB Ken Seals was a late scratch and Mike Wright got the start (11 of 21 for 206 yards with a 1-1 ratio) and will get the start again here. Mississippi St comes in off the 40-point loss to Alabama. The Bulldogs are -0.42 in ypp margin (No. 97). We have this one near the number.



**Wisconsin 21 PURDUE 16.** We circled this game as a possible bet on Wisconsin. We were hoping the market would be around "Pick" and we wanted to fade Purdue off their big upset win over No. 2 Iowa. Wisconsin is +142.9 ypg on the season, No. 11 in the country. What surprised us is Purdue is No. 15 in the country at +129.3 ypg. Wisconsin is on a 14-0 SU (+20.6 ppg) and 11-3 ATS (+7.3 ppg) run in this series. We see another win and cover for them. Totals' players note the UNDER is 6-0 in Purdue games this year going UNDER by an average of 16.7 ppg.

**OLE MISS 42 Lsu 33.** A lot of unknowns to sift through here. First, kudos for LSU in their performance last week against Florida. The Tigers got the big outright win that still didn't save Coach O's job. Do they continue to play that way down the stretch despite being banged up? Speaking of banged up, it appears Ole Miss QB Matt Corral could be questionable here. He gave a valiant effort in the win over Tennessee last week (231 passing and 195 rushing). We're passing until his status clears.

**South Alabama 31 UL-MONROE 17.** This is another game where we circled South Alabama as a possible bet. We want to fade ULM off the biggest upset in college football in 4 years. In fact, their win over Liberty as 32.5-point underdogs last week was the biggest upset involving two FBS teams since 2012. You could have found ULM as high as 41/1 on the money-line Saturday. Even with 3 wins on the season, ULM is dead last in ypg differential (-193.8) and No. 129 in ypg margin (-2.41). Meanwhile, South Alabama is +89.9 ypg (No. 34) and +1.03 in ypg (No. 39). We were hoping to see a -10 to -12 spread here but at -13.5, we don't see as much value.

**Liberty 38 NORTH TEXAS 20.** Similar to wanting to fade ULM off last week's historic upset, we wanted to back Liberty after losing such a game. Time and time again, head coach Hugh Freeze has been among the best, if not the best in CFB in covering point spreads. Considering Marshall was just -11 at North Texas last week, we were anticipating a Liberty -17 line. We bet numbers, not teams, so when Liberty opened -22, we bet North Texas. The Mean Green are really bad but they still move the football on offense averaging 416 ypg. We also took UNDER 66.5 on the openers.

**Utah 33 LOUISIANA TECH 26.** Louisiana Tech really let us down on these pages last week. Considering what their offense did vs Mississippi St (34 points) and NC State (27 points and 480 yards), we were stunned they only managed 3 points vs UTEP. It was one of our worst picks of the season. Now the Bulldogs welcome in the unbeaten Roadrunners who find themselves ranked for the first time in school history. UTSA is 6-1 ATS this season covering by an average of 8.3 ppg. However, we're wary of fading LT head coach Skip Holtz as an underdog. We're not involved.

**Western Kentucky 44 FIU 31.** For the first time this season, an UNDER hit in a WKU game and we lost on these pages taking the OVER in their game vs Old Dominion. The Hilltoppers still put up 43 points and the OVER drops to 5-1 in their games (+13.4 ppg). They are No. 4 in ypg on offense but No. 122 in ypg allowed. Meanwhile, FIU is off a bye. The OVER is 5-1 in their games this season going over by 10.3 ppg. Now you see why this total is in the upper 70's. We were a bit surprised to see WKU open as 17-point road favorites. We feel FIU is in the same realm as Old Dominion power ratings' wise. WKU was only a 13.5-point favorite last week.

**3★ San Diego St 21 AIR FORCE 20.** Could be a Mountain West championship game preview. These teams are pretty evenly matched but San Diego St has the better ppg and ypg margins. It's the irresistible force vs the immovable object. Air Force's No. 1 rush attack averaging 336 ypg vs San Diego St's No. 1 rush defense allowing just 61 ypg and 2.1 yards per carry. With such a low, we could only look towards San Diego St here catching more than a FG. San Diego St has won 8 straight vs Air Force. Make it 9!

**NOTRE DAME 31 USC 25.** One of the best rivalries in all of college football. A game that didn't get played last year for the first time since World War 2. Notre Dame has won 7 of the last 10 meetings. Both are coming off a bye. Obviously, you trust Notre Dame's coaching staff more than USC's with an interim coach. The Trojans have won 8 straight road games. The stats are pretty even but ND has played the tougher schedule. We missed Notre Dame -4 on the opener as that's where the money has been early this week. We lean UNDER.

**FRESNO ST 33 Nevada 30.** The winner gets a big leg up in the West division of the Mountain West. Both teams had misleading wins last week. Nevada was +5 in TO's vs Hawaii in a 17-point win. Meanwhile, Fresno St was +5 in TO's vs Wyoming in a 17-point win. Nevada is No. 31 in ypg margin while Fresno St is No. 14. Both teams have played similar schedules in terms of strength. We bet UNDER 66.5 on the opener and still like it.

**HAWAII 40 New Mexico St 20.** These two just played back on September 25th. Hawaii was a 17-point road favorite and won 41-21. That's why we were surprised the Sunday openers had Hawaii as a 14-point home favorite. Yes, the Warriors are banged up right now but if Chevan Cordeiro returns at QB, we have a really good bet. Even if he is out, we think the current line of 18 is giving New Mexico St a ton of credit. Sure, New Mexico St has covered 2 straight as big underdogs since that loss to Hawaii. The Aggies are still -2.11 in ypg margin (No. 124). We lean Hawaii.

## Week 8 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 3-6 and are 30-38 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 4 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Eastern Michigan -3**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

#### Thursday, October 21st

**CLEVELAND 20 Denver 19.** Both teams come in reeling off upset home losses. As we're typing this on Wednesday morning, Cleveland will be without QB Baker Mayfield, RB Kareem Hunt, RB Nick Chubb and two starting OT's. Case Keenum will start at QB. Meanwhile, Denver QB Teddy Bridgewater is also less than 100% and they have injuries at LB. After a 3-0 start, the Broncos have lost 3 straight games outright all as a favorite. Clearly, they were over-valued in the market after beating a bunch of weak teams in the Giants, Jags and Jets. We're leaning UNDER.

#### Sunday, October 24th

**BALTIMORE 27 Cincinnati 20.** Baltimore has won 5 straight since the season-opening loss to the Raiders in OT. They are an AFC-best 5-1 and dominated the Chargers at the line of scrimmage last week (187-26 rushing edge). Meanwhile, the Bengals are 4-2 and have already matched last year's 4-win total. The Ravens crushed the Bengals in last year's two meetings 65-6! We're leaning with Baltimore here as it will be interesting to see how Cincy fares in a big game. We do like the Ravens in a teaser (see above). Totals players note that the UNDER has cashed in 5 straight Cincinnati games this season.

**Carolina 22 N.Y. GIANTS 19.** After a 3-0 start, the Panthers have now dropped 3 straight games including last week in OT to the Vikings. Meanwhile, a short-handed Giants team was crushed at home by the Rams. The Giants are now on a 19-51 SU run and are 7-19 ATS as a home underdog. They could be without RB Barkley and WR Golladay again here. We lean UNDER here.

**GREEN BAY 30 Washington 19.** Since the disastrous blowout loss to the Saints in Week 1, the Packers have won and covered 5 straight games. QB Aaron Rodgers moved his career record to 22-5 vs the Bears last week. Rodgers has a 14-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in their 5 game win streak. They're taking on a Washington team that is a NFL-worst 1-5 ATS. The Football Team's defense has allowed 29 or more points in 5 straight games, a franchise record. They are really banged up on offense and could be without RB Antonio Gibson. Go Pack!

**Kansas City 30 TENNESSEE 27.** Tennessee comes in off the upset win over Buffalo on MNF which cashed as our top play on these pages. KC is off a comfortable win at Washington. The Chiefs had a dominating 499-276 yard edge but are still only 3-13-1 ATS in their last 17 games. The look-ahead line on this game was Kansas City -3. Why are we now sitting at KC -5.5? Both teams over-achieved and should be upgraded in power ratings. We like Tennessee here even though they are on short rest.

**Atlanta 24 MIAMI 23.** Miami comes in off the London trip while Atlanta is off a bye after also making a trip to London. The Dolphins have dropped 5 straight games since their season-opening win over the Patriots. They were banged up entering last week's game vs Jacksonville and a lot of money came in against them on game day in their loss. They did get Tua back at QB. Meanwhile Atlanta is 2-3, their best start since 2017 and QB Matt Ryan has a 8-to-0 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 3 games. We think Miami is a solid teaser option here getting them teased up to "+8.5".

**2★ NEW ENGLAND 26 N.Y. JETS 16.** Last week's loss on these pages with the Patriots hurt bad considering the finish. Still, New England was outgained 567-335 and were fortunate to get to OT in the first place. NE intercepted Jets rookie QB Zach Wilson 4 times earlier this season in the Pats 25-6 road win. Coming off a bye has Wilson improved? The Pats are 0-4 at home this season and desperately need a feel-good win. They have won 12 straight times over the Jets and remember Belichick is 23-6 SU his last 29 games vs rookie QB's. We like the Patriots here.

**L.A. RAMS 32 Detroit 16.** Obviously, the big story here is Jared Goff's return to L.A. while Matthew Stafford plays his former team. It's played out as expected with the Rams 5-1 and the Lions 0-6. The Lions come off their worst performance of the season in a blowout home loss to the Bengals. Meanwhile, the Rams are off a blowout win over the Giants last week. They have lowly Houston on deck so we don't think there is motivation issues here. The Lions are really banged up especially on offense and have been shutout in the first half in 3 of their last 4 games. More of the same here. We lean UNDER.

**LAS VEGAS 26 Philadelphia 23.** The Raiders pulled the upset in Denver last week in their first game without Jon Gruden. Meanwhile, the Eagles got the back-door vs Tampa Bay in a 28-22 loss. They have extra rest having played on Thursday and have fared better on the road this season including a pair of wins. We're not involved in this game as there are still too many unknowns on how the Raiders psyche is with an interim.

**TAMPA BAY 28 Chicago 18.** Tampa Bay is 5-1 SU on the season but just 2-4 ATS as you're paying a bit of a premium on the defending champs. This is another big spread here especially considering the look-ahead line was Tampa Bay -10. Yes, the Bears fell short vs the Packers but not to the tune of making this big of a line adjustment. The Texans lost those games by a combined 71-3! The Cardinals crushed us on these pages last week in their blowout win over the Browns. They did it without their head coach Kliff Kingsbury. They remain unbeaten but have huge games vs Green Bay (next Thursday) and San Francisco on deck. We question their motivation for margin here. However, former Texans WR Hopkins and DE Watt may differ with that thought. We lean with the UNDER.

**2★ UNDER 44 SAN FRANCISCO 23 Indianapolis 18.** San Francisco comes in off a bye after a rocky 2-3 SU and 1-4 ATS start. The 49ers have failed to cover in 3 straight games but played Green Bay, Seattle (with Russell Wilson) and Arizona. They're taking a step down in class here. They're also taking on an Indianapolis team that has covered 3 straight games and just crushed Houston. It's a classic "Buy Low, Sell High" handicap for us. We lean San Francisco here no matter who starts at QB Jimmy G or Trey Lance. However, San Francisco has dropped 6 straight at home and 8 straight as a home favorite. That's why we prefer the UNDER especially with an early forecast of 16 mph wind and rain.

#### Monday, October 25th

**New Orleans 23 SEATTLE 19.** Early money has been on New Orleans in this one as a sharp betting group with market influence has been on the Saints here. They come in off the bye after we cashed on them in their win at Washington. Meanwhile, Seattle comes in off the SNF loss to the Steelers in OT. Geno Smith was 23 of 32 for 209 yards and a TD but had a fumble in OT. We're not going to be involved much here other than a lean on the UNDER.
