## **Mr. Eyerman - CRS Principal**

- Board meeting tonight, 11/4, unveiling semester two return to learn plan and directives for consideration and discussion
  - Full day return for all grades (including MS) starts semester two, at CR we have already undertaken some of the marching orders for this when the other grades went back full-time
  - We are hoping to be in a pilot position to start full time for all before winter break, but still unsure at this time
  - Working out how lunch will look
- Staffing:
  - Mr. Kozimor left last Friday, looking for permanent replacement for 7th grade and STEM
  - Looking for part-time LRC and Spanish
  - Disappointment with applicant pool quality and quantity thus far
- Metrics: cases per 100 reached red metric last week, doesn't necessarily change anything at this point, no danger of us shutting down right away. If we are advised to start taking different measures, there will be a lead-up to that process, it won't be immediate.
- Student behavior on campus has been excellent
- Great turn-out for mask policy and hand washing on campus
- Parent drop-off and pick-up, please don't make u-turns at south curb or pick up on north curb
- Virtual spelling bee on-campus (possible date 12/20), will be broadcast live for parents at home
