# SEWER AND PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

Roe submitted a sewer report handout, attached to minutes. CC lift station has had no issues since two new pumps have been installed. Roe reported on CC lift station upgrade with Jason Robertson and his superior from Fluid Equipment. New pumps will be 480Volts; some electrical work will be needed but should not cost more than the initial quote. A different generator will be needed to run the CC lift station. The old generator can be used at Northview lift and E Hwy lift station. Hokanson and Roe will check on temporary generator fixes until one can be purchased.

CITY CLERK Resignation from Chris Robinson on Board of Zoning Adjustment (BZA). Vacancy is posted.

Third scholarship received for Dee she is covered at 100% for City Clerk Conference. Clerk reported she will not be hiring a high school intern this year; this can resume when needed. We now have welcome bags at City Hall; usually bags are given out when sewer deposit is made. Ault wants to personally give out bags in her ward. Other board members are ok with giving bags at time of deposits.

Redistricting will not happen for a while. Census Bureau has announced redistricting numbers will not be ready until September 30, 2021.

MIRMA evaluation completed. Received 97%. City will get a credit on assessment.
