



January 13, 2021 - COVID Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home!

At the present time there are no new cases of COVID-19 for staff or residents. Our resident who recently tested positive remains asymptomatic and no other staff or residents have any COVID symptoms. We have one floor that is on precautionary isolation as per DOH guidance until January 21st. We continue close monitoring of all residents as well as limiting movement of staff and residents to other floors. Weekly testing of residents and twice weekly testing of staff will continue indefinitely.

Visitation remains on hold until further notice, but virtual visits are available daily and are highly encouraged. To schedule a virtual visit with your loved one, please contact Social Services or Recreation and someone will be happy to assist you.

As an additional precautionary measure, all postal and personal care packages received for our residents are sanitized and held for 24 hours before giving to our residents so please plan accordingly.

Regarding the COVID vaccine, we have confirmed that CVS Health will return to Midway on January 20th to administer 2nd doses and 1st doses for newly admitted residents and residents who have not yet received the vaccine. If you still need to give your consent for your loved one to receive the vaccine, please call the facility as soon as possible to give your consent to a registered nurse. As COVID positivity rates continue to rise across our area, we ask that you and your families take extra precautions to be safe.
