Systematic Theology

Systematic theology is a discipline which addresses theological topics one by one (e.g. <u>God</u>, <u>Sin</u>, <u>Humanity</u>) and attempts to summarize all the biblical teaching on each particular subject. Sometimes called constructive theology or even dogmatic theology, the goal is to present the major themes (i.e. <u>doctrines</u>) of the Christian faith in an organized and ordered overview that remains faithful to the biblical witness.
