## Regular Season Recap for BP Sports

With only 8 games remaining in the football season (7 NFL playoff games plus the National Championship), we thought it would be a good time to recap the season here at BP Sports. First, we couldn't be here without your support and patronage. Again, we can't thank you enough that you took a chance on us in these first couple of seasons of BP Sports and for that we'll be forever grateful to you.

One year removed from an historically great season, it was NOT a good season on these pages especially on the college side where we finished an extremely disappointing 31-37-3. We are 21-18 in the bowls so far so hopefully it was more of an out-lier type of year. Rest assured we will be making some changes in our CFB handicapping process in 2020 as this season was unacceptable. On the positive side, the NFL remains super strong as we've never had a losing season in the NFL on these pages and we've never been below 56% in any season! That is extremely rare and it shows in the 5 year cumulative records (see page 3) as we're dominating the competition.

It does give us great pleasure that when you factor in the combined record in the last 5 years, we are the No. 1 most accurate newsletter (see page 3) in the regular season by far. It's not even close as we have a 27-game lead on the Sports Reporter in terms of overall net wins in CFB/NFL.

As with any season win or lose, there are still many lessons to be taken from this year. First and foremost, there are no guarantees in this industry and winning consistently is very hard to do. Keep in mind, the Nevada sports books have now shown a profit in each of the last 75 months. Their last losing month came way back in July 2013. That's some pretty stiff competition we're going up against every single week, month and year. With this sub-par season, we'll obviously try to learn from it as the market continues to evolve especially with the legalization nation wide brings more money and competition into the market place.

Clemson (SU: 14-0, ATS: 11-3, O/U: 6-8)		2019 Season Stats		Clem	LSU	Lsu 35 Clemson 34. We just feel this is a classic overreaction to what the public just saw last. Before the semifinals one sports book at Clemson -1, one book had LSU -1. Our power ratings had the game at "Pick" (Clemson 103.5, LSU 101) after you give LSU 2.5-points of HFA for playing in the Super Dome. We downgraded Clemson 1-point for their performance against Ohio St even though they won and covered. On the other side, we upgraded LSU 2-points for crushing Oklahoma (our pure power ratings now have LSU -3). Even going through the position-by-position breakdown on the left we can only get LSU to -3.5. Therefore we feel there is value on Clemson here. Remarkably, there's been value on them all season as Clemson is two FG's away from being 13-1 ATS! Remember, Clemson head coach Dabo Swinney in the post-season since 2012 is 9-2 SU (+12.1 ppg) and 10-1 ATS (+14.2 ppg) with Clemson being an underdog in 9 of those 11 games. While LSU QB Joe Burrow has deservedly gotten all the love from the media note that Clemson QB Trevor Lawrence has 22-0 TD-INT ratio since October 26th. The underdog has covered in 6 straight Championship games and this is the longest gap in between the semifinals and the championship game in the 6-year history of the CFB Playoff. Advantage Clemson in that they were in that war vs Ohio State.

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# AFC/NFC Divisional Forecasts

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Saturday, January 11th

**NFC Divisional: Minnesota at San Francisco. 4:35pm ET on NBC**  
**1★ Minnesota (+7). SAN FRANCISCO 26 Minnesota 21.** This is the 49ers first playoff appearance since 2013. We feel San Francisco's defense is overrated. In the first 7 games of the season, the 49ers allowed just 11 ppg (No. 1) and 224 ypg (No. 1). However, in the last 9 games they have allowed 26 ppg (No. 24) and 326 ypg (No. 9). The 49ers struggled against play-action this season and the Vikings are one of best play-action teams in NFL especially with a now healthy Dalvin Cook at RB. Also Minnesota WR Adam Thielen is healthy as he had more receiving yards (129) vs the Saints than he had in the previous 5 games combined (109)! Finally, Minnesota head coach Mike Zimmer is the most underrated coach in the NFL. If you have been blindly betting on Minnesota since he started (2014) you are 60-34-6 ATS (64%) including 43-18-3 (70.5%) vs non-division opponents! The 49ers are not good front-runners as they are 9-21-2 ATS as favorite since early in the 2014 season. Finally, road underdogs are 85-61-6 ATS (58%) this season!

**AFC Divisional: Tennessee at Baltimore. 8:15pm ET on CBS**

**1★ UNDER 47. BALTIMORE 28 Tennessee 17.** Baltimore is the first team to enter the playoffs on at least a 12-game winning streak since the 2007 Patriots. They broke the record for most rush yards in a season with 3,296. The Ravens in their last 10 games (when they became healthy at CB in Jimmy Smith and picked up Marcus Peters) were 10-0 SU (+20.5 ppg) and 9-1 ATS (+15.3 ppg). On the other side, Derrick Henry was the first player to have 200+ scrimmage yards vs a Belichick team in playoffs as the Titans got the upset win. However, Tannehill only had 72 passing yards and a 39 QBR. The Titans after a 2-4 SU/ATS start with Mariots were much better with Tannehill at QB at 8-3 SU (+6.6 ppg) and 8-3 ATS (+5.8 ppg). We have two run-heavy teams here and note there is rain and wind in the weather forecast.

Sunday, January 12th

**AFC Divisional: Houston at Kansas City. 3:05pm ET on CBS**

**1★ Kansas City (-9.5). KANSAS CITY 31 Houston 20.** Kansas City head coach Andy Reid off a bye in his career is 23-5 SU and 19-9 ATS exceeding expectations by 5.5 ppg! Houston did win at Kansas City back in Week 6 31-24 as 4-point underdogs. However, KC is a much different team since that one. First, QB Patrick Mahomes wasn't 100% for that game. Second, Kansas City's defense has made major improvements. In the first 10 games of the season the KC D allowed 23.9 ppg (No. 19) and 369.5 ypg (No. 23). However, in the last 6 games they have allowed just 11.5 ppg (No. 1) and 316.5 ypg (No. 7). We feel this KC team is better than the one that was one play away from the Super Bowl last year. Also in the advanced analytics, there is a huge disparity here as Football Outsiders' DVOA has KC as the No. 2 team in the NFL while Houston is No. 19. One of the keys in having success vs Houston is getting after QB Watson who was sacked 7 times last week. Note that KC is Top 10 in adjusted sack rate. Houston is No. 26 in pass defense and is now taking on a healthy Mahomes. Houston head coach Bill O'Brien is 0-9 SU (-19 ppg) and 2-7 ATS (-8.3 ppg) when catching 7 or more points since 2016.

**NFC Divisional: Seattle at Green Bay. 6:40pm ET on FOX**

**1★ UNDER 47. GREEN BAY 24 Seattle 21.** In head-to-head meetings between Aaron Rodgers and Russell Wilson, the home team is 7-0 SU and 6-1 ATS (+8.6 ppg). Something has to give here as the Seahawks were 8-1 SU on the road this season while Green Bay was 7-1 SU at home. Generally, speaking we feel both of these teams are overrated. Seattle is 11-2 in one-score games including the playoffs this season. The Seahawks have tied the 2015 Broncos for the most one-score wins in a single season including playoffs all-time! Seattle was just +1 ppg and -1 ypg this season despite having 12 wins. Meanwhile, Green Bay despite notching 13 wins and the No. 2 seed was just Green Bay +4 ppg and -7 ypg this season. The early weather forecast has temps in the mid-20s. We'll take the UNDER which was 7-1 in Green Bay's last 8 games.
