Who is our Archbishop?

Two weeks ago at Synod, the Diocese of the Holy Cross voted overwhelmingly to accept the invitation of The Anglican Catholic Church (commonly referred to by the initials *ACC*) to join them as a Non-Geographical Diocese. By voting to join the ACC we join a Church with parishes throughout the United States, and all over the world. We also now have an Archbishop, the Most Reverend Mark Haverland while still remaining under the Diocesan leadership of the Right Reverend Paul C. Hewett. Archbishop Haverland is the sixth Archbishop of the Anglican Catholic Church.

"Our Archbishop and Metropolitan is the Most Reverend Mark Haverland. He is a graduate of Kenyon College with a bachelor's degree in political science, and holds an MA in Roman Catholic theology from Duquesne University, and a Ph.D. in religion from Duke University.

Ordained to the priesthood in 1982, he served for twenty-four years as rector of St. Stephen's Church, in Athens, Georgia. In 1998, the then Father Haverland was elected and consecrated as Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of the South, succeeding the late William O. Lewis. At the XVI Provincial Synod in 2005, he was elected to succeed the retiring John Charles Vockler as Archbishop and Metropolitan of the Anglican Catholic Church.

He is author of <u>Anglican Faith and Practice</u> an introduction to orthodox Anglican belief and has written articles and reviews for publications such as *Touchstone*, *The New Oxford Review*, and *The Journal of Religion*.

As Archbishop, he is the head of the College of Bishops of the ACC's Original Province."
