In The Beginning II

I. God's Existence Based on Evidence:

- A. Rom. 1:20 - Material objects testify to the perfection of God manifested in them.
- B. Psa. 90:2 - "Even from everlasting to everlasting"

II. When God Created:

- A. The Power of God is manifested:
 - 1. Job 9:4-12 - The power of God expressed
 - 2. Col. 1:15-17 - "in Him all things consist."
- B. All creation has a purpose:
 - 1. Eccl. 3:1, 17; 8:6 - "to every purpose there is a time and judgment"
 - 2. Isa. 43:1, 7 - Created for my glory.

III. Characteristics of God: Exod. 34:6-7

- A. Merciful: Compassionate
- B. Gracious: "good and kind to men, without any merit or desert of theirs, but bestows good things on them freely" (Gill).
- C. Slow to Anger (ASV) Longsuffering (KJV):
- D. Abundant in Lovingkindness
- E. Abundant in Truth:
 - 1. Jn. 17:17 - Sanctify in truth.
 - 2. Josh. 24:14 - "Serve Him in sincerity and truth..."

- G. Forgiving: "Out of His grace, God alone "forgives" sin"... "to pardon" (Vine's). "to lift, bear up, carry" (BDB).
 - 1. Iniquity:
 - a. The most basic meaning is wickedness; immorality, etc." The word signifies an offense, intentional or not, against God's law.
 - b. "to be bent, bowed down, twisted, perverted" or "to twist, pervert." (Vine's).
 - 2. Transgression:
 - a. "transgression; guilt; punishment; offering."
 - b. A willful deviation from, and therefore rebellion against, the path of godly living.
 - c. Amos 2:4 - transgressions = a revolt.
 - 3. Sin:
 - a. "to miss, sin, be guilty, forfeit, purify" (Vine's). The word's chief usage to indicate moral failure toward both God and men, and certain results of such wrongs (Vine's).
 - b. Prov. 19:2 - "He that hasteth with his feet sinneth."
 - 4. Just: "will by no means clear the guilty" Nah. 1:3-9; Exod. 20:7
