They Provide Expert Resources: In addition to pure financial coverage for legal expenses, many concealed carry insurance plans offer a host of other resources.



Parting Shot: Concealed carry insurance is akin to your self-defense gun; it's unlikely you'll ever need it, but if you do, you really need it.



Dry Firing – [Mantis Laser Academy](#)

Mantis Laser Academy (following information it from their website)

With guided drills and real-time feedback, Laser Academy allows you to have a training facility at home and at your convenience. Get quality reps with your own equipment and experience a higher level of dry fire training with positive results you can see and feel. Laser Academy's variety of drill options also keep things fresh for shooters, making practice feel more like a game and less like a chore.

The Laser Academy system utilizes a laser training cartridge that drops into the chamber of your firearm, delivering a laser beam down the barrel every time the firing pin strikes the round. Using physical targets, these laser "shots" are read by your phone or tablet and scored accordingly, per mode. The simplicity of the setup is what provides the flexibility for when and where you can practice.



Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals overturns federal GCA

US Circuit Judge Julius

Richardson in his ruling. "In the law, a line must sometimes be drawn. But there must be a reason why constitutional rights cannot be enjoyed until a certain age. Our nation's most cherished constitutional rights vest no later than 18. And the Second Amendment's right to keep and bear arms is no different."

It was not clear what effect the ruling would have. The New Orleans-based Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals ruled in an opposite manner on the same issue several years ago. This is a case that might wind up going to the Supreme Court for them to rule.

NICS and Gun Sales

Excerpt from The Gun Feed ([NSSF-Adjusted NICS Background Checks for June 2021](#))

The June 2021 NSSF-adjusted National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) figure of 1,279,300 is a decrease of 41.3 percent compared to the June 2020 NSSF-adjusted NICS figure of 2,177,586. For comparison, the unadjusted June 2021 FBI NICS figure 3,042,379 reflects a 22.2 percent decrease from the unadjusted FBI NICS figure of 3,909,502 in June 2020.
