Re: Off Season Security Concerns – Waskesiu Townsite, Prince Albert National Park

The Waskesiu Seasonal Residents Association (the “WSRA”) represents cottage and cabin owners in the town site of Waskesiu, Prince Albert National Park (“PANP”).

Our Association is prepared to discuss options to help improve town site security. We are also prepared to play a role in helping to inform our affected members in the unfortunate event that further break-ins do occur in the off season.

Over the past two years there have been a large number of break-ins when all the cottage and cabin residents are absent from the Park. We are aware that in the past there have been problems in contacting owners whose cabins/cottages have been broken into. In an effort to assist you we are prepared to act as intermediaries in contacting residents who you need to contact. If there is a cottage/cabin owner who you need to contact and you are unable to secure an address or e-mail we would be prepared to attempt to contact them and have them call you. We have an up-to-date list of almost all cabin/cottage owners that includes e-mail addresses for over 320 of them.
