**It's time to change the culture that accepts slow play. Help us solve one of golf's biggest problems and play faster!**

We hear too often how frustrated golfers are with lengthy rounds. With this pace of play program, we look forward to working with Southland golf courses and industry leaders to make golf more enjoyable for everyone involved with the game by gathering feedback and highlighting success stories. Help us by signing the pledge, putting the bag tag on your bag and sharing these tips with your foursome!

### Helpful Tips:

Play ready golf throughout the entire round

Walk fast

The first person to complete each hole should immediately go to the next tee and is expected to be the first person to tee off. The second person to finish should replace the flagstick.

Know where your group is in relation to the group in front of you

Get your yardage and be ready to play before it is your turn to play.

If someone isn't quite ready to play, another player should play before them

When any shot heads toward rough, a water hazard or trees, all players should watch closely as to where the ball lands

Read your putt before it is your turn to play

Recognize when someone will need the flagstick attended or your ball marked.

Place your golf bag or park your golf cart near the next teeing ground

If your ball might be lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds, play a Provisional Ball (Rule 27-2)

**Sign the pledge today and receive a limited edition Pace of Play bag tag! Expect your bag tag to be shipped within 2-3 weeks.**

### The Spirit of the Game

Golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

## Tournament News

### President's Cup Qualifier

We had 67 Players turn out for the President's Cup Qualifier. This qualifier determines which members will be included in the 64 man field (16 per flight) that will compete in match play over the next several weeks, and compete to be the President's Cup Champion.

Last year's champion was Boone Barrow and he got an automatic entry as the #1 seed in the "C" flight. Make sure that you are familiar with the rules of match play, it is different than stroke play. The rules were on the check-in table; but if you didn't get a copy there are copies in the golf shop and on the web site.

Please direct any question on the match play or schedules or results to Doug Benc or call me if you need assistance. In the individual low net portion of the Presidents Cup stroke play, Greg Entrup took 1<sup>st</sup> place in the "A" flight with a net score of 73, followed in 2<sup>nd</sup> place by Chris Fitch with a 74.

Coming in with a 75 Darrel Wilson took 3<sup>rd</sup> and Dean Milligan grabbed 4th with a 76. In the B Flight, Doug Benc scored 73 for number 1 spot and Aaron Prisock nabbed 2<sup>nd</sup> with a 75. Jack Springer and Robert Johns tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> with 77's. C Flight winners included last year's Cup winner Boone Barrow taking 1<sup>st</sup> place with a 68. Roger Gilley and Jim Moir tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> with 71's. Fourth place at 75 went to Angel Barnuevo in a card off.

Lee Sherman led the D Flight with a 66 followed by Dave Devries with a 68. Mike Younger Sr, Doug Murphy, and Bob Hoover tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> with 72's. I sent out the payoff sheets on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> so you should be getting a check/script in the mail soon. Please let us know if you have any concerns.

You must have played in one tournament this year, or else play to your L.I. Partners are limited to 8 stroke differential. During the President's Cup Tournament we drew two 50/50 tickets and I would like to congratulate Chris Fitch and new member Charles Groce as the winners.

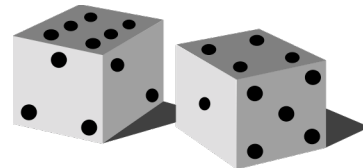

## Golf:

**Thursday May 16-** Skins game at Los Lagos with a shotgun start at 12:00. Cost is \$60 which includes green fees, cart, net and gross skins (please pay separately from the fee list on application).

**Friday May 17** - Gross and Net Skins Game (flighted) with closest to pin at Mohave Golf Resort- Shotgun start at 8:00.

**Saturday May 18-** Flighted tournament at El Rio County Club paying low gross and approximately 30% of the field for low net with gross skins/closest— **2 or 3** flights depending on entries. Shotgun start at 8:00.

## Socializing

- Awards Ceremony 6:00-7:30PM Saturday at the Aquarius Hotel & Casino with a full buffet dinner (fish, chicken, and beef) and a no host bar.
- Entertainment / camaraderie—must see to believe.

## Lodging

- Aquarius Hotel & Casino with a 3PM check in time.

## Payment

- The prices on the entry form include everything required: hotel, golf, cart, range balls, prize money, and the socializing mentioned above.
- The entry form with money attached is requested by Mar 30 with final deadline Apr 15. Will not commit Men's Club money for people who have not paid (you are not in until I have your entry fee in hand) but will refund all possible if you have to cancel later.
- Guests are welcome and male guests are eligible to cash (provided they have an established handicap) in everything except the low gross/net on Saturday. Subtract \$20 from price list on entry form for male guest and call me for a price if female golfer playing.
- Our Pro Shop professionals are also welcome.

## Prize Money

Other than rooms and golf, the major expense is the awards ceremony/ buffet —please check “no” on the entry form if you do not plan to attend because I have to pay in advance based on the number of people that sign up to attend. No cost for significant other for Awards Ceremony but \$25 for each additional guest. There is a built-in \$20 discount for those who stay at the Aquarius to encourage socializing and fun. After room, golf, and awards ceremony costs, the remainder of the entry fee goes into prize money and allows for substantial payoffs in each flight and very sizeable skins pots. For the Thursday skins game, \$40 goes to green fees and \$10 into gross and \$10 into net skins pot.
