**A Note from Rick:** Markets were steady to stronger throughout the day on Tuesday at TLA. Springers and dairy cows sold steady at best with the better springers bringing \$1100-\$1250 and the better cows at \$1000-\$1100. The calf market was stronger for both heifers and bulls. The top half of the bull calves brought \$85-\$120 with the bottom half bringing \$50-\$85. We had a good run of heifer calves as well, with the majority of the calves bringing from \$85-\$125. Feeders, both steers and heifers, sold very well again. This market, along with the butcher cow market, has settled in as our strongest and most consistent over the last 3-6 weeks. Something that really stood out to me this week was the appearance and condition of the livestock brought in Tuesday. Cooler more moderate temperatures compared to last weeks heat and humidity played a big part. The difference showed mostly in the baby calves and butcher cows, both markets were considerably stronger this week. Our Dutch Cross Classic last weekend was a success with a good lineup of horses from top to bottom. I want to thank all consignors and buyers for their business and for helping us to get this sale off the ground! Catalogs are in the mail for the Summer Draft Horse Auction on June 22<sup>nd</sup> and flyers will be mailed out this week for the Driving Horse Auction on June 23<sup>rd</sup>.
