Pamlico Air to Create Investment and Jobs

RALEIGH: Pamlico Air, an air filtration manufacturing company, will expand its North Carolina operations with a new facility in Beaufort County, creating 39 jobs, Governor Roy Cooper announced today. The company will invest \$1.4 million in Washington.
