PROPER FORMS OF THE COMMUNICANTES **On the Nativity of the Lord and throughout the Octave** Celebrating the most sacred night (day) when blessed Mary the immaculate Virgin brought forth the Savior for this world, and in communion with those whose memory... † **On the Epiphany of the Lord** Celebrating the most sacred day on which your Only Begotten Son, eternal with you in your glory, appeared in a human body, truly sharing our flesh, and in communion with those whose memory... † **From the Mass of the Paschal Vigil until the Second Sunday of Easter** Celebrating the most sacred night (day) of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ in the flesh, and in communion with those whose memory... †

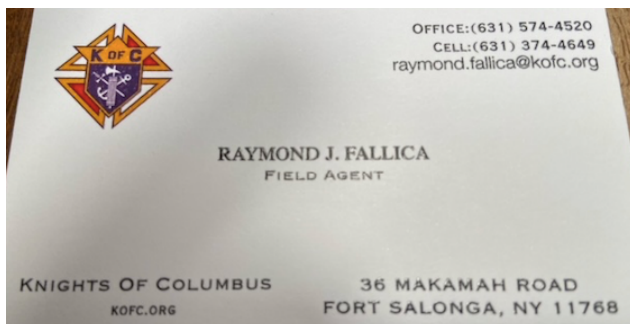
