AN ORDINANCE

Adopting and Amending ordinance No. 2019-56 (Permanent 2020 Appropriations) by decreasing appropriations and appropriating from unappropriated funds in the General Fund, the Police Training Fund, Fostoria RLF-City Fund, CHIP Fund, and Storm Water Fund and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That ordinance No. 2019-56 (Permanent 2020 Appropriations) passed December 17, 2019, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

SECTION 2: That Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 101-740-531215 General Fund – General Government-Auditor/Contractual Services-Computer Maintenance.

SECTION 3: That Six Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$615) be decreased from funds appropriated to 206-100-530210 Police Training Fund – Security of Persons and Property-Police/Contractual Services-School & Training.

SECTION 4: That Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 240-499-531700 Fostoria RLF-City Fund – Community Environment-Community Development/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 5. That Thirty Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty One Dollars (\$35,351) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 245-428-531700 CHIP Fund – Community Environment-CDBG/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 6. That Twenty Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Six Dollars (\$25,286) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 245-435-531700 CHIP Fund – Community Environment-OHTF/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 7. That One Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Thirty Dollars (\$138,030) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 245-439-531700 CHIP Fund – Community Environment-HOME/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 8. That Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$30,400) be appropriated from unappropriated funds 245-441-531700 CHIP Fund – Community Environment-Other Program Income/Contractual Services-Other Contractual Services.

SECTION 9. That Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) be appropriated from unappropriated funds 521-522-559004 Storm Water Fund – Basic Utility-Storm Water/Capital Outlay-Infrastructure.

SECTION 10: That this ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

SECTION 11: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 12: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Fostoria and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2020 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

THEREFORE, upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, and signature by Mayor, this ordinance shall take immediate force and effect.
