... The Installation of Officers will be held on June 22nd at 6:00 pm, please try your best to attend.

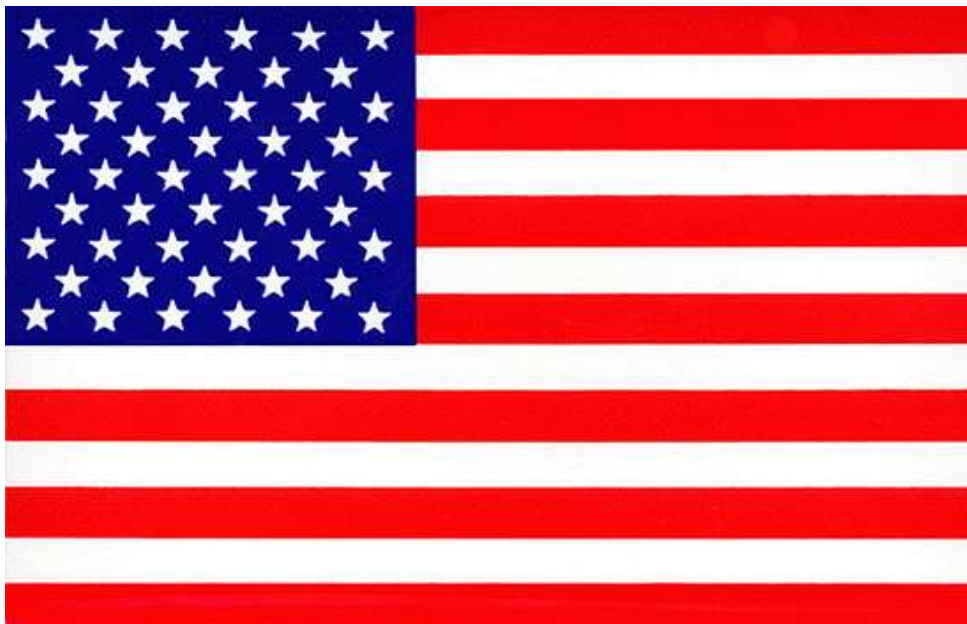
