Grounds - From Rd 3 North in Chino Valley, go North on US 89 approximately 9.1 miles to Verde Ranch Road. (Approximately 3/10 miles past mile marker #338). Turn right onto Verde Ranch Road. Follow signs to trial grounds. Approximately 5 miles.

From Ash Fork on I-40 - Take Exit 146 Go South on Highway 89 approximately 24 miles to Verde Ranch Road (about 7/10 mile past mile marker #337) turn left and follow signs to grounds. Slow down at the Bramble/San Francisco Streets sign. The left turn onto Verde Ranch Rd is very sharp.
