November 13, 2017 Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of Polk Fire-Rescue, Inc., held at Polk Fire-Rescue, Inc., was brought to order by president, James McCall, at 7:00PM with 13 members present.

FIRE POLICE Marshall Sherman said the county fire police will have nomination of officers at next meeting.

EQUIPMENT/APPARATUS Thomas Sherman reported that the committee met and recommended to not pursue replacing Engine 4 at this time. He said that there hasn't been enough response by personnel to have two engines leave the station since August. He did say that mechanical issues are inevitable. Brian Heffern asked what will happen if Engine 6 is out of service. Sherman said he has started talks with other companies that have multiple engines and may be able to borrow for a time. Sherman said Engine 6 needs upgrades and estimated at \$30,000 by one vendor. By show of hand vote, majority in favor of not pursuing replacement of Engine 4 at this time.

<u>WAYS AND MEANS</u> Andrea Buckley gave an update on breakfast fundraiser.

Richard Schaeffer asked about ordering job shirts. Thomas Sherman said that Sheila Sherman will put an order in. There will be a sign up sheet in office.

BUILDING COMMITTEE Thomas Sherman said the roof leaked into the post office when we had heavy rain. He reminded personnel that Hepler Roofing was paid \$15,000 to replace the roof. Nick Hepler came out last week and resealed around the vents. Contractor James McCall will look at it. Brian Heffern motioned for president and treasurer to make a decision on repairs, if needed. Evan McNeely seconded. Motion carried.
