APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AND AWARD INFORMATION

- The Grady County Fairgrounds Trust will award two, \$500 scholarships to two graduating high school seniors in Grady County.
- Students must be seniors in high school in order to apply.
- Students must attend school in Grady County in order to apply.
- Students who are homeschooled must reside in Grady County in order to apply.
- Scholarships will be judged and ranked by a qualified third-party.

ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE PAYMENT AND METHOD OF PAYMENT

- No later than August 1st following the recipient's high school graduation, recipient must submit proof of enrollment from his/her college, university or vo-tech. Proof of enrollment should be sent to the Grady County Fairgrounds Trust, 500 E. Choctaw Ave., Chickasha, OK 73018, or jamie@gradycountyfairgrounds.com
- Upon receipt of proof of enrollment, the Grady County Fairgrounds Trust will mail a check for the total scholarship amount to the recipient's college, university, or vo-tech to be applied toward his/her first semester of school.
- o Recipient must be considered a full-time student at his/her college, university, or vo-tech.
- Recipient must complete the first semester of school and maintain a 2.5 GPA.
- Should the recipient fail to submit the proper documentation for payment, the recipient automatically forfeits the right to any scholarship payments.

The Grady County Fairgrounds Trust Scholarship must be used at an accredited Oklahoma College, University or Vo-Tech. No payments will be made to out-of-state-schools.
