White Wines By the Glass

- Gloria Ferrer Brut Sonoma** \$9
"From almost 92% Pinot Noir with the remainder Chardonnay, this is a dry, elegant, fairly priced sparkling wine tasting of ripe stone fruit. The finish ends sweet, begging for spicy food to complement." Wine Enthusiast
- Walter Hansel "The North Slope" Chardonnay** \$16
"Pure and juicy, with vivid, silk-textured blackberry and wild berry flavors, featuring fine-grained tannins that grip the flavors" Wine Spectator
- Morgan "Un-Oaked" Chardonnay** \$10
"Pure and ripe, offering juicy notes of honeydew melon, ginger, spice and nectarine, ending with a sustained finish that echoes the core fruit flavors." Wine Spectator
- Cakebread Sauvignon Blanc** \$14
"A tight, citrusy sauvignon, this opens to tart yellow cherry flavors as the fruit lengthens into the finish. It has a floral note of wild flower honey that recalls the sunniness of Napa valley. Clean and refreshing." Wine and Spirits
- Voss Sauvignon Blanc** \$8
"A minerally, sea salt thread runs through the center of this wine, with grapefruit-scented citrus and stone fruit flavors, centered around vivid acidity." Wine Spectator
- King Estate Pinot Gris** \$9
"There's extra richness across the palate of perfectly ripened apple, pear and melon fruit." Wine Enthusiast
- J Bookwalter "Couplet"** \$6
"...offers aromas of fresh lemons, honeysuckle, lemon grass, Asian pears and honeydew melons. The symphony of fruit on the palate echoes the aromas and is accented by subtle hints of minerality, quince and cashew dust" Winemaker
- Bucklin Rose** \$8
"Dry and crisp, it blooms with dewy pale berry flavors" Libation
- Charles Smith "Kung Fu" Riesling** \$6
"Lychee, citrus, mint and classic minerality all show here, and it's medium bodied, beautifully balanced and finishes cleanly, with perfectly integrated acidity and only subtle sweetness." Robert Parker

Red Wines By the Glass

- Bucklin Cabernet Sauvignon** \$13
"...has fruit aromas of cherries, currants and plums. There is a modest background of eucalyptus and lavender spice with oak wood and toast aromas." Will Bucklin
- Waterbrook Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon** \$9
"Sleek and expressive, this is well-modulated and refined to show the ripe blackberry and cassis flavors elegantly, framed by flashes of caraway, dill and red peppercorn that glide together into a polished finish." Wine Spectator

- Markham Merlot** **\$11**
 "Supple and zesty up front, with flavors of ripe red currant and toasty spice that take on structure and tannins on the finish" Wine Spectator
- Belle Glos Pinot Noir** **\$17**
 "Presents a distinctive mix of raspberry and huckleberry flavors that border on jammy, shaded by smoky, toasty oak. Turns graceful and elegant, with supple, refined tannins and lingering flavors of herb and black olive." Wine Spectator
- Ponzi "Tavola" Pinot Noir** **\$13**
 "Fresh and inviting, with cherry and raspberry notes at the core, showing cinnamon and hibiscus hints around the edges. The flavors float easily into the long, expressive finish." Wine Spectator
- Ridge "Paso Robles" Zinfandel** **\$16**
 "Nicely briary and distinctive, with tart cherry, underbrush and spicy mineral aromas that lead to layered, vibrant flavors of wild berry, toasty dill and fennel." Wine Spectator
- Carol Shelton "Wild Thing" Zinfandel** **\$8**
 "Vibrant and zesty, offering smoky cherry aromas and complex briary raspberry, underbrush and cracked pepper flavors" Wine Spectator
- Bedrock "Lorenzo's Heritage"** **\$16**
 "Full-bodied, juicy and succulent with good underlying structure, this mouth-staining and mouth-filling, dry red should drink nicely for a decade." Robert Parker
- Inizi Charbono** **\$10**
 "Charbono is an old-fashioned variety that used to be planted in Napa Valley, before Cabernet Sauvignon took over. This bottling is bone dry and tannic, with lots of acidity. The wine is made in a style of 30 or 40 years ago, which is meant as a compliment. It's a complex, food-friendly wine of considerable interest."

- Morgan "Cotes du Crowes"** **\$8**
 "Sleek, polished and easy to enjoy, with a rich, medium-bodied core of red fruit, red licorice and black cherry. The tannins add good grip on the finish. Syrah and Grenache." Wine Spectator
