FIRE DEPARTMENT:

OLD BUSINESS

- Scott Brown's property is making progress. We received the signed copies where the
 certified letters were sent. We have sent a mailed copy of the certified letter to Scott
 Brown on the advice from the Fairfield County Prosecutors Office. Trustee Wolfe and
 Zoning Inspector Hogle will schedule another date to go back out and revisit the site for
 an updated cleanup list to be bided out.
- 2. Windy Hills Road property nuisance issue is now back under the control of Roger Ruble. He will be backfilling the holes and addressing the property.
- 3. Shelly will come back in the spring to place the AC bands on the driveways on Meister Road. Pictures and addresses were taken.
- 4. Next joint zoning meeting will be February 8, 2024 at 6:30pm. At the last meeting we met with Attorney John Albers and the meeting was full of useful information. Will be moving onto the next steps.
