Need help paying your PSE Electric bills?

The PSE Home Energy Lifeline Program is designed to provide income-eligible households with bill payment assistance. This program grants a one-time payment for qualifying households per program year.

What are the income guidelines?

To qualify for assistance, your household monthly income should not exceed the limits below:

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	MONTHLY INCOME
1	\$1,485
2	\$2,003
3	\$2,520
4	\$3,038
5	\$3,517
6	\$3,775
7	\$4,038

What information do I need to provide?

- Puget Sound Energy bill
- Picture IDs for everyone 18 years old or older
- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of Homeownership or Rental agreement
- Income for all the members of the household for the last 4 months prior to your appointment. This includes but is not limited to: Pay stubs, Unemployment benefits, TANF, GAU, Social Security benefits, Veterans benefits, Pensions, L&I, Self-Employment earnings, Rental income, and Child Support.
