Memories from the Past

Several of our tournaments have names that are rarely or never used today. Our club has been around for forty years and our founding board members did a remarkable job with its Bylaws and Policy Manual. The later was a 26 page document that delineates who we are and how we operate.

Nial Hickman was our founding President. He served in that capacity for several years. Nial loved the club and the course, so much so that he bought an ownership share in the Limited Partnership. Our President's Cup Qualifier has been designated the Nial Hickman Memorial since the early 90's.

Our four-club red tee tournament is officially known as the Ed Malone Red Tee Tournament. This event was especially appropriate to be named in Ed's honor. Hitting from the red tees was the only way Ed could reach the par 4's. Ed was one of the longest serving board members. In his later years he not only got shorter off the tee but showed the effects of becoming elderly. One day he showed up to the course with his bowling shoes.

Bill Karsner was our first Social Chairman. At one point our four-man scramble was named in Bill's honor. Bill was responsible for our monthly dinner meetings which, in the first 30 years of our club, would attract 60 to 80 members. There was also a Christmas dinner dance that Bill handled. In addition to organizing our monthly dinner meetings, Bill helped out in other ways. Bill organized a travel event several times a year, providing an opportunity for our members to enjoy some of the finest courses in Southern California. It not only included booking tee times, these events included bus reservations from El Prado. Bill also originated and ran the Tuesday Skins Game for years, an event that is now a staple of our services.

There are others who have made contributions to our club in the course of its history but we have chosen to recognize only Nial, Ed and Bill. We owe a great deal to these founding board members.
