DECISION 2019 - WILL THE VOTERS SAVE TEMPLETON FIRE?

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED to help with Measure "A" Precinct Walks

Members of the "Save Templeton Fire" Committee will be doing a "precinct walk" on Saturday, July 20th and 27th from 9 am to about noon and need your help to get it done! The goal is to reach out to every resident and business – person to person – in the town of Templeton prior to the arrival of the Measure "A" ballots at the end of this month.

WHAT IS MEASURE "A"

In a special all-mail election that ends on August 27th, voters in the town of Templeton will be asked if they support a special tax levy on real property in order to provide 24/7 Fire & Emergency Services. The measure will require a 2/3 majority vote to pass. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to read the full text of the ballot measure.

HOW TO HELP "Save Templeton Fire"

A "Save Templeton Fire" campaign committee has been formed to help raise awareness and get the word out on the importance of a YES vote on Measure "A". Ballots will be hitting mailboxes at the end of July and must be returned no later than August 27th.

Volunteers are needed for precinct walks, to pass out literature, help by posting a “YES on Measure A” yard sign on their property, and through donations to help pay for literature, mailings, yard signs and banners.
