MY GRATITUDE AND THANKS

I had my left leg below the knee amputated on the 30th June 2015 and at that moment when I had to make the decision to allow amputation, I felt that my world was gone, as I had always been a sporting person; playing football, swimming, walking and other daily activities that I pursued. I thought initially that my work days were also over, but this was not so. I was in a depressed state on leaving the hospital after my operation, as I was facing a lengthy period confined to a wheelchair.

An organisation called ACSIL helped me mentally and physically to get through my depression, through these bad times. I would advise any person who has undergone or who is undergoing an amputation; if you are feeling down in any way then I would strongly recommend you contact ACSIL and speak to a member. I guarantee they will help you so much up to the point of them convincing you that you do have a future in this world: through ACSIL I met many people that have been through similar circumstances but with a lot more difficulties, none more so than a certain member called Robbie Winterson, who helped me through so much to accept my disability and eventually face up to life. Robbie is a remarkable person who is a very

influential person within the organisation. With his help he gives a lot of other people, new members, new amputees just out of hospital etc. We meet every Thursday afternoon and it is a pleasure to all meet up as a group. Robbie keeps us all alert with his wit, his outlook on life, and mostly his brave personality. Without Robbie on a Thursday it would be a sadder place. The organisation (ACSIL) need people need people like him to be in attendance as his most gifted talent is that he cares at all times for other people. A big thank you to Robbie, Peter, Bobby and all other members of ACSIL for helping myself through my sad and depressing time. God bless you all.

Introduction to ACSIL

What we do: We provide free and confidential support in the Liverpool and Merseyside area for people for whom an amputation may be necessary or who already are amputees, this also extends to their families, partners and carers.

Support: Based on first hand experience we can provide advice, practical help and support when and where needed. Much of our support is given in hospital prior to the operation and just after the operation.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

It is with great sadness that we have to once again ask for volunteers to help at the Royal Hospital and the Prosthetics and Wheelchair Centre at Aintree. Unless we get more volunteers, we won't be able to offer these services.

DON'T LEAVE IT TO OTHERS

Volunteers are only needed on a monthly basis for one or two hours at Aintree and the Royal to meet and greet other amputees who might need help or advice.

We are making giant strides to get into the Royal and hopefully we will have our own room where we can talk to people in private. Ladies can be accommodated with a lady amputee if required to offer help and advice from a female perspective.

And after: The Amputees and Carers Support Group is an active and dynamic group who meet regularly and organise social events to benefit members.

Our social day is on a Thursday between 10.30am and 4.15pm where you can chat and socialise with other people in a similar situation as yourself. We also provide day trips on specially adapted vehicles.


