BAPTISM STIPEND - \$25.00 - Baptisms are normally celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of the month (after a Baptism Preparation Course has been completed).

BAPTISM PREPARATION: The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

MARRIAGE STIPEND - \$200.00 - Please allow at least six months between the time of contacting the Parish and the date of the Marriage. **A Marriage Preparation Course is required.**

FUNERAL STIPEND - \$200.00 - St. Joseph's Parish has a Bereavement Committee which will contact you to coordinate the funeral services.

UPDATE ON PUBLIC HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR CHURCHES

Next weekend, August 29th & 30th, in keeping with provincial mandatory mask regulations for indoor public gatherings, parish members are to wear a face covering on entering and leaving the Church. Masks may be removed once seating has taken place. A mask is to be worn during the communion procession and removed prior to receiving Holy Communion.

Also our Church will be permitted to have a maximum of 100 members per Mass, provided physical distancing is maintained. Finally, please continue to phone the Parish Office on Wednesday or Thursday to indicate your intention to attend the Mass of your choice. Registration will also take place at the entrance for those who have not pre-registered. This is a Public Health requirement for any public indoor gathering, in the event that contact tracing would be necessary.

aAUGUST 28 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT AUGUSTINE, BISHOP, DOCTOR: Augustine (354-430), born in North Africa, abandoned his Christian faith but later embraced it, thanks to the prayers of his mother Monica and the influence of the great Bishop Ambrose whose sermons convinced him of the truth of Christianity. At Easter 387, Augustine was baptized by Ambrose. In 391 he was ordained a Priest, and in 396 he became Bishop of Hippo, where he spent the rest of his life, working and writing. His intelligence and pastoral concern shaped the thought of Western Christianity and guided the Church for over a thousand years. Augustine is one of the greatest Fathers of the Church.
