

Brookfield East Friends of Fine Arts, Inc.

Senior Scholarship Application

The Brookfield East Friends of Fine Arts (FFA) is offering several scholarships of \$500 each to BEHS seniors graduating in June 2022 who will attend a four-year university or two-year technical program. The scholarships are offered to students who have been involved in the fine arts at Brookfield East, which include Band, Orchestra, Choir, Drama, Forensics, and the Visual Arts. The scholarship applications are due no later than 11:59 pm CST on Saturday, April 2, 2022, and the recipients will be announced at the Senior Recognition Night in May (TBA).

The Friends of Fine Arts scholarship committee will select and award scholarships based on the application and the depth and breadth of involvement in the fine arts at Brookfield East, within a program and/or across the fine arts. Volunteering in the arts, including the FFA's annual Holiday Arts & Craft Fair is a factor.

By submitting a complete application, you are stating its contents are accurate and give permission to the FFA to follow up or to verify any information provided. Applicants are required to submit their most recent transcript to verify enrollment in arts programs at Brookfield East.

Transcripts are available on Infinite Campus (submit transcript that includes Term 3 of senior year, 2022). After completing the application questions, please save the application as a PDF with the following requirements:

- Please name your pdf application and transcript in the following format using your last name as "lastname" and your first name as "firstname":

- Email the PDFs of your application and transcript from your personal email account. **Do not** use your Elmbrookschools school email account. After you graduate, the district will deactivate your school email address. Email your PDF application, along with a PDF of your most recent transcript, to brookfieldeastffa@gmail.com

- Confirm the email address. We will email timely applicants back to confirm that we received your application within 2 days of receipt. We are confirming the receipt of the application. We are not confirming that it is complete. No late applications.

Do not use color type for your application, as we print applications for the Scholarship Committee with black ink only. Use 12 pt. font for your responses. The deadline is 11:59 p.m. CST April 2, 2022.

Late applications and paper applications will not be considered.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

If selected, the scholarship award will be paid directly to the student's college in the fall of 2022, after completion of an acceptance form (by August 2022). Students who have been awarded a full academic scholarship at the institution they will attend are not eligible to receive this scholarship. Selectees must use the scholarship award in fall 2022 (no gap year or deferred awards). Acceptance of this award constitutes permission for the FFA to use the recipient's name, image or likeness for promotional or publicity purposes without written consent or compensation.

For music classes, specify which band, orchestra, or choir groups you participated in each year. For drama or musicals, list your participation (role, pit orchestra or crew area) in each production. - **Describe any awards or recognition you earned during your involvement with fine arts, both at Brookfield East and outside of BEHS during high school.**

- **Do you plan to continue with the Fine Arts after graduation from Brookfield East? Describe anticipated school/personal/ community involvement.**

- **Have you been awarded a full academic scholarship or “full ride”?**
