

**CITY OF WENDOVER**

**Resolution 2017-12**

Utah Election Code provides for the cancellation of an election required pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Section 20A-1-206(13) U.C.A.,

- (i) All municipal officers are elected in an at-large election under Subsection 10-3-205.5(1) and
- (ii) The number of municipal officer candidates, including any eligible write-in candidates under Section 20A-9-601m for the at-large municipal offices does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have files; or
- (iii) There are no other municipal ballot propositions
- (iii) The municipality, not later than 20 days before the day of the scheduled election, adopts a resolution that cancels the election and certifies that:
  - (i) each municipal officer candidate is: unopposed; or a candidate for an ot-large municipal office for which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices; and
  - (ii) a candidate described in subsection (1) (c) (i) is considered to be elected to office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved** by the Council of City of Wendover as follows;

- 1. The City Council certifies that:
  - (a) Mike Crawford, is the only eligible candidate who filed for election in one four-year term open at-large office of Mayor, scheduled to be filled at the November General Election, and there are no eligible write in candidates under Section 20A-1-206; and
  - (b) There are no eligible candidates for election in two four-year term open at-large positions of City Council, scheduled to be filled at the November General Election, and
  - (c) There are no other municipal ballot propositions.
- 2. The City Council hereby cancels the local election in accordance with subsection (1) and gives notice that the election is cancelled by posting notice:
  - (a) On the Statewide Electronic Voter Information Website as described in Section 20A7-801 for 15 consecutive day before the day of the scheduled election;
  - (b) At least twice in the *Wendover Times* before the day of the scheduled election; and
  - (c) In at least three conspicuous places within the boundaries of the municipality at least 10 days before the day of the scheduled election.
- 3. This resolution is to take effect immediately and the City Council are instructed to proceed in compliance with the provisions of Section 20A-1-510(1)(b).
