What is the “Bible Project?”

The Bible Project is a new course designed to enable congregation members to get an understanding of the whole Bible. It puts the content of Scripture in a thematic frame using visuals, photos, and learning tools. *It's time to upgrade our engagement with the Bible.*

What the Bible Project is NOT:

The Bible Project is not a Bible survey course nor an in-depth study. Inspiration will come as the Holy Spirit enlightens our minds to see and perceive, to hear and understand what the Word says.

Who will be leading and teaching?

For the past 2 years, 15 of your fellow members have been preparing for September, 2018. Their names and pictures are in Brochure. They have read, studied, and 11 are preparing to teach God's eternal Word in a new way. The next **Stage 2.0 is for everyone** who will give 1 hour a week in four 10-week sessions over the next 2 years to complete the whole Bible. Those who complete The Project will know God and God's will much better than when they started.

What will be covered in the Bible Project?

Creation to the final Re-creation of the new heaven and the new earth in 20 Old Testament portions and 20 New Testament portions.

I have heard how intensive the Bible Project for teachers is, will it be that hard for those who sign up for Stage 2.0?

NO. The congregational stage 2.0 will be only ONE hour per week and will be less demanding. Preparation will be suggested but not required. No one will be “put on the spot” about their preparation or their Bible knowledge. And no one will be expected to teach.

Will there be homework?

Bible readings will be recommended for class preparation and handouts will cover the teaching points week by week. Visuals will reinforce The Big Ideas. Scripture location “Markers” will reinforce where to find certain passages. While optional, all preparation will increase learning.

Will a weekday class be available?

That depends on finding the day and time when a sufficient number would like to take the class.

What will be the start date for the first quarter?

Wednesday classes will start **September 5, 2018**. Sunday **September 9, 2018**, will be the first Sunday.
