Walt and Gayle Kibby have been members of Parkside church for about as long as they have been married - 55 years in December. Gayle is a 3rd generation member, her grandparents, John and Johanna Jansen, were charter members of Berean



Church and her parents Jacob and Lillian Jansen, were also members. Several of Gayle's aunts, uncles and cousins attended the church at that time.

Gayle was born and raised in Holland, attended Holland public schools and graduated from Holland High School. Walt grew up in Allegan, attended Allegan Public Schools and graduated from Allegan High School. He has a degree in engineering from Allied Institute of Technology (AIT) in Chicago and Gayle has a business administration degree from Davenport College.

Walt and Gayle met in 1960 and dated briefly before he moved to California while Gayle attended Grace Bible College. They attended Kramer's church - it had been pastored by J.C. O'Hair. Their daughter, Michelle, was born in 1966 following Walt's graduation. Walt and Gayle returned to Holland for a couple years before moving to Jenison to be closer to his job in Grand Rapids. Riverbend Bible Church in Walker was their home where they attended the young married's class called Homebuilders. After 7 years in Jenison, they lived in Zeeland for twenty years before moving to their home on Silverstone Road in Holland in 1997.

While attending Berean Bible Church, Walt served

as a Board member, S.S. teacher, S.S. Superintendent, Awana youth leader, and was on the Mission Committee. Gayle served as S.S. teacher, S.S. Treasurer, helped with the Awana Club and participated in the women's ministries. They attended the Berean Duets, a young married group, and have many fond memories of those times. Since returning to Parkside, Walt has been an usher, greeter, prayer partner, worked with the children and helped with mowing. Gayle participates in bringing treats to new visitors.

Since 2006, they have spent winters in Bradenton, FL, where they attend the First Church of the Nazarene and participate in their senior activities. Gayle helps with building and grounds maintenance and Gayle attends the knitting and sewing circles with a missionary outreach.

Walt enjoys his antiques hobby, exercising at Evergreen Commons and golfing while Gayle likes sewing, knitting and being with family and friends.
