

## **NEW COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FOR MASSES**

St. Joseph's church is allowed 30% capacity for each mass. Therefore there is room for 125 people at each mass. Our attendance at Saturday evening mass is typically approximately 50 people so we have room for another 75 people on Saturday so we encourage more people to come on Saturday evening. Then there will be more room for social distancing at Sunday Mass.

Please make sure that you are well before you come to mass. If you are feeling any COVID symptoms please stay home and watch the mass on social media. The Bishop's dispensation from coming to Sunday Mass is still in effect at this time.

**ENTERING CHURCH** When you come to the church please social distance 6 feet and enter through the center main front door. There are automatic hand sanitize dispensers on each side of the main entrance. Each person must sanitize their hands before coming into the church.

**THE OFFERTORY BASKET** will be just inside the entrance. Please drop your envelope or offering in as you enter. If you have special collection envelopes from during COVID closure time you can drop it in at this time as well.

<u>USHERS</u> will great you when you enter the church and show you to your seat. The church will be filled from front to back keeping parishioners at a social distance from each other. Families and households will be placed seated together. Please follow their direction.

<u>WEEKEND READINGS</u> will be read by one assigned person each mass. They will do the First Reading, Responsorial Psalm and second reading only. The Gospel and Prayers of the Faithful will be read by Fr. Sany. This way the reader does not need to come back to the Ambo after Father has been using the podium.

<u>FOR COMMUNION</u> Fr. Sany will come to your pew to distribute Communion. Please <u>do not</u> process up the aisle. Communion will **not be given on the tongue**. Communion is to be received on the hand only at this time.

<u>WHEN EXITING</u> please exit from the back to the front of the church. Please use the side doors only and keep a social distance of 6 feet. Please do not congregate on the church grounds after mass as there is still a limit on gatherings.

NO OTHER MINISTRY PERSONS will be required during Phase II of COVID re-opening and until further notice.

Please stay safe and be patient as we all work through these changes together.
