

From Pastor Travis's Study

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace in the name of Jesus Christ who is our Savior and healer of our brokenness.

As we come into the month of March, I cannot help but get excited. Not only is it the month that I was born in (March 14), or that the ACC and NCAA basketball tournaments are soon here, or that baseball season is soon to start, I am also excited that Spring is almost here. I love the spring and summer seasons.

When I was younger, I could not wait for Spring to come. It meant that I could go outside and play with my friends. We could go outside for recess and play kickball. And, remember: The Best Is Yet to Be!!!





Leadership Team Report...

The Leadership Team did not formally convene in either December 2023 (normal holiday hiatus) or January 2024 (weather). What follows is from its meeting in February.

The Team asked into the current status of the Bethany Hygiene Kit program, which has, for a long while, been guided on the giveaway side by Jessica Allshouse. Jess takes what is donated (mainly personal care products, like soaps, deodorants, and grooming supplies) to the Shikellamy School District where she works. The goods are dispensed free and freely to students, not as kits containing specific items, but out of bins a la carte. The program is doing very nicely and will continue as it now goes. This update will come as welcome news to our membership, many contributing members of which are to be thanked for their support of this initiative.

Bethany will provide a special breakfast casserole on Easter Sunday, March 31, at 9:00 AM (worship service at the regular 10:30 AM time).

Bethany was recently graced with a heartwarming "thank you" card from the YMCA daycare children that were treated last Halloween in front of the church office. That had been a special treat that we aimed specifically at those particular kids, and their gratitude, both at the time and through their card, so moved us that we wasted no time deciding to do the same sort of candy handout for them for Easter. This is a very brightening thing, not only for the church, but for the delighted kiddos and their appreciative morning Y staff monitors.

We are still waiting to hear from our contactor contacts and the Conference Property/Casualty Insurance firm as to (a) whether the check we received to repair the church's northern Front St. hand railing is at all adequate to the cover the expected cost (we think not), and (b) who would be the logical choice to do the work in view of who the original installer was. . Meanwhile, the damaged railing will be taken away from that area, largely because it's high time to undo the eyesore.

We approved obtaining a standalone speaker that would have amplification enough to help with the audibility of our large TV and with that of people speaking/ teaching / leading in the church's fellowship area. Rod Moore





• The contracts for maintenance of the landscaping (trimming, fertilizing, spraying for pests) with Creative Plantscapes for the 2024 season for the parsonage and church were signed and returned with

• The plumber completed the annual test of the backflow preventer on the church water supply on February 15. It's working properly. The plumber will file the necessary paperwork with the water

• Based on my concern regarding the high water bills for the church, I contacted the water company for further information. What I learned is that the sprinkler system requires a 4" line and meter. The monthly fee is based on the size of the meter, which is approximately \$285 plus the cost of water used. • Bob is contacting Hemmler and Camayd to check on the progress of the design of the roof over the Center Street Ramp.
