- All finalist must make himself /herself available for an **interview** upon reasonable notification by the Scholarship Committee.
 - All finalist bring a recent headshot photo (passport size preferred) to interview

- Part III Letter of Reference (1)
- Part IV Transcript
- Part V Letter of Acceptance

All sections must be completed and submitted. Submission of an application with **incomplete information** will result in the student not being eligible for scholarship consideration.

Deadline: Postmarked – **March 31, 2018** *(no exceptions)*

Notification: Notification of the award – by student’s Seniors Class Night *...only those awarded will be notified*

III. LETTER OF REFERENCE:

One letter of reference must be submitted from an educator.

The letter of reference must include the title, address, email and telephone number of the person making the recommendation. Copy of letter will be acceptable.

IV. TRANSCRIPT: (*unofficial accepted*)

Submit a **COPY** of your current transcript. The transcript should reflect:

- Current courses
- Numerical grades
- MCAS scores from previous years

If any of this information is missing, ask your counselor how you can obtain this information.

V. LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE: Applicant must have applied to be enrolled in an accredited college or university, including two-year colleges. Awards will be issued only to those who show proof of acceptance into a university or college.

- ❖ Any applications postmarked after the deadline will be disqualified.
- ❖ Any application missing any information will be disqualified.
