

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
JULY 10, 2017

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Delcambre met in regular session at 6:00 p.m., on July 10, 2017, at the City Hall, with the Honorable Pam Blakely, Mayor, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderman Timmy Derise "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of July 10, 2017." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timmy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved the authorization to pay bills approved by the finance committee." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timmy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to abandon Debuse road with Jace Migues responsible for all costs incurred and Jace Migues to grant 10' - 12' servitude". Motion Carried:

DISCUSSION: Council to determine procedure and letter of collection for town bills going back three (3) years.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timmy Derise and second by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to allow Police Department to utilize bank/credit card processing provided by Gulf Coast Bank of Delcambre. A three-month average to set processing fee". Motion carried:

RESOLUTION: Millage rates determined and adopted for the town of Delcambre, Louisiana Iberia & Vermilion Parishes at a rate of 6.01 for the year of 2017. City Attorney, Ted Ayo presented Resolution with a response of YEAS: 5 NAYS: 0 ABSTAINED: 0 ABSENT: 0

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timmy Derise and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve new solid waste and bulk waste pick up provider, Pelican Waste and Debris, with a rate per resident of \$12.99 per month. Regular trash pick-up every Wednesday and bulky waste every other week to begin on August 1st 2017. Mayor Blakely approved to sign contract on behalf of Council". Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timmy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "motion to approve Patrolman Travis Mestas move from temporary to permanent position. Motion Carried:
