



Membership **renewals** received after Jan. 10<sup>th</sup> will be sent back to the local auxiliary with a request for a **current <u>COPY</u>** of the New Member Application. The member has lost continuous membership and is a NEW MEMBER.



Congratulations to all the newly elected and appointed Department of New York Officers and local officers. As we go forward throughout the year I want to wish you all the beat of success in your programs and your work to maintain the aims and purposes of our Amvets Ladies Auxiliary.

AMVETS National Ladies Auxiliary recognizes the official uniform as an A-line forest green dress, an A-line forest green skirt, or tailored forest green slacks. Dress to have a jewel neckline. White or gold jewel neckline blouse may be worn with either the skirt or slacks. The dress and skirt should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee and no longer than 4 inches below the knee. White blazer with large Auxiliary patch on left breast. Black shoes with a closed heel and toe, heel should not be higher than 2 inches. Black handbag, white gloves, and official Ladies Auxiliary hat. Pearl earrings and single strand pearl necklace, or Auxiliary necklace and earrings will be acceptable. White shoes, purse may be worn from April until Labor Day. There are to be no pins worn on the official hat except for those earned, Convention pins are restricted.

As the newly elected Sergeant-at-Arms I urge you to start familiarize yourself with the AMVETS National Ladies Auxiliary Constitution and By-laws Manual and Forms (revised 9/1/2016). The manual is an excellent resource guide, in addition to providing you with information on the roles and responsibilities of being a Sergeant-at-Arms; it also includes information on the America flag protocols, parades, proper care of the standards and permanent retirement of the colors; the official hat and uniform, and various ceremonies.

I hope everyone enjoys the rest of the summer, and look forward to seeing you all in October.




This year we will not be adding any names to the Memorial Service on the night of the Service. This will make the Services run much smoother.

There are many Parliamentary Courtesies that are expected by all members and I would like to name just a few.


- 1.) Stand when addressing the President when making a motion, discussing a question or giving any report.

- 6.) I would like to add one that I feel is justly important —" Be Yourself, Everyone Else is Already Taken."


