The Beverly Shores Green Space Committee and the Environmental Restoration Group will be conducting training on Town Green Space properties in invasive plant identification and removal. Attendees will receive a free copy of *A Beginners Guide to the Plants of the Indiana Dunes*

The training will take place on Saturday, August 28 and Monday, August 30 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., on Friday, September 10 at 1:00 to 2:30 p.m. and Saturday, September 11 from 9 to 10:30 a.m.

You only need sign up for one though if space is available, you can sign up for more than one session. Location details will be provided prior to the training to those signing up. Training will focus on identification and removal of burning bush, privet, Japanese barberry, autumn olive, glossy buckthorn and oriental bittersweet. Tools will be available for participants. Tools will also be made available for loaning at a later date to homeowners by ERG for invasive plant removal on their own properties.
