## ABOUT THE CHICKAROO CLASSIC

The Chickaroo Classic was established in 2008 to honor our daughter Caroline (the Chickaroo), who was diagnosed with a Pediatric Low-Grade Astrocytoma (PLGA) in 2007 when she was six-years-old. She's endured more than eight years of chemotherapy, three brain surgeries, and so much more to halt the growth of a plum-sized mass and other lesions within her brain and spine. She's lost all usable vision in her left eye and has no right peripheral vision. She is presently enrolled in a clinical trial at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Through all this, Caroline has never complained and remains positive and hopeful.

PLGAs are the most common pediatric brain tumors. There is no cure for PLGAs, and many, such as Caroline's, are inoperable. First line treatment has not changed in over 30 years and is toxic, ineffective, and causes significant and permanent collateral damage to growing children.

Since 2007, Team Chickaroo has raised over \$900,000 for PLGA research. In 2018 we expect to reach \$1 million! Funding by families such as ours has contributed to more progress in understanding and treating this disease than ever before. Hope for genuinely effective therapies is now quite real. The most significant obstacle to change is the lack of funding. All proceeds from the Chickaroo Classic will fund research at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute's PLGA laboratories.
