WITHOUT HEARING I'LL NEVER KNOW

This is my second article of five about the plan of salvation. This is based upon what God Himself has stated in the Bible. Last time we stated that faith is the foundation of each one of these steps.

In Romans 10 the question is asked, "How can anyone believe in someone if they have never heard about them?" Now, I believe that anyone can believe in God without hearing about Him. They may not call Him God, but all they have do to is look at the miracle of creation and see that there has to be a supernatural power out there somewhere. You just had selective hearing. You selected not to apply what you heard, but right now you still can. Jesus is calling you to come to Him and receive His grace. Can you hear Him?
