

CABIN CREW TRAINING (2 MONTHS



Skyy Aviation Academy offers cabin crew training with a license from the South African Civil Aviation Authority.

In order to work as a flight attendant, one has to acquire a cabin crew member license.

We at Skyy Aviation train and prepare candidates in all of the relevant components required for licensing. Training is provided by experienced instructors and designated examiners recognized by the South African Civil Aviation Authority.

Components covered during training include

- 1. Safety and emergency procedures
- 2. Aviation Fire
- 3. Aviation Medicine
- 4. Aircraft Specifics
- 5. Dangerous and Hazardous goods
- 6. Ditching
- 7. Aviation General including Air law
- 8. Soft Skills services procedures etc.

Each **component** receives individual certification. An overall license is awarded on completion of an external examination conducted by the SACAA.
