

Safety Considerations

With the start of the school year more students are walking to bus stops and many neighbors are driving to work or school. To help keep everyone safe, please trim any shrubbery or trees that can interfere with walking on the sidewalks or line of sight at intersections. Please be courteous and follow the Fairfax County guidelines when parking on the streets near intersections:

- Parking is not allowed within 30 feet of a stop sign
- Parking is not allowed in or within 20 feet of an intersection. Radius is from where the pavement begins to curve for the cross street.

If you observe an issue, you can offer a gentle reminder to your neighbor and you may contact the Fairfax County Police Non-Emergency number: 703-691-2131, if necessary.

2019 – A Successful Season for the Hurricanes

For those of you who have followed the steady progress of your neighborhood swim team, **the Hiddenbrook Hurricanes**, you know that the team has grown and become more successful over the last several seasons. In one of the largest and most competitive swim leagues in the US, the Northern Virginia Swim League (NVSL), your home team again competed in Division 4 (of 17 divisions with six teams in each) for 2019. Our meet results are as follows:

While our competitive record in Division 4 may not be indicative the success we experienced this year, there is much that our swimmers, coaches, and the Hiddenbrook Swim & Tennis club can be proud of:

- Division 4 was the most competitive in the NVSL this season, with the fewest points separating the first-place team from the last place team.
- The 2018 team was the largest in Hiddenbrook history 219 kids on the roster.
- Of the 219 swimmers, more than 60 were in our Waterspouts developmental (ages 3-6) program which bodes well for our future success
- Over 100 Hiddenbrook S&Ts member families participated in 2019 summer swim.
- The team set 23 Hiddenbrook club records this season one of which was set way back in 1994!
- Hiddenbrook sent 11 swimmers to the NVSL All-Star meet the most in recent history.
- We also sent 13 kids (six relays, both relays for 8&U boys, 9-10 girls and 13-14 boys) to the NVSL All-Star Relay Carnival – and our 8&Under Boys team took FIRST PLACE in both the Free and Medley relays.
- Beyond all that, nearly every one of our swimmers set personal best times this year and continued to improve upon those times as the season progressed!

Many thanks to the Hiddenbrook Swim & Tennis Club membership for your ongoing support. We gave it our all this year and very much look forward to coming back stronger and faster for the 2020 summer swim season. **Go Hurricanes!**


