- A. Yeah, there was an oak that developed a crack
- 2 between two co-dominant stems, and obviously it was
- 3 threatening to fail. And they immediately approved my
- 4 recommendation to repair the tree.
- Okay. Can you give me another example?
- A. I can't think of any specific ones, but there
- 7 were times when I pointed out limbs overhanging cabins
- 8 that they usually approved without argument.
- 9 Q. Can you give me examples of recommendations
- 10 that they would argue about? By they, I mean the
- 11 camp.
- 12 A. Yeah, I was -- at every visit I would always
- 13 discuss fire safety, and they always resisted the
- 14 thinning projects that I talked about.
- Q. Okay. Can you give me another example?
- 16 A. No.
- Q. Now, you said you know who Ken Kramarz is,
- 18 correct?
- 19 A. Yes.
- 20 Q. How many times would you estimate that you have
- 21 met him?
- 22 A. Ten.
- Q. And how many times would you estimate that you
- 24 received push-back or argument from the camp in
- 25 implementing any of the recommendations or work that you
